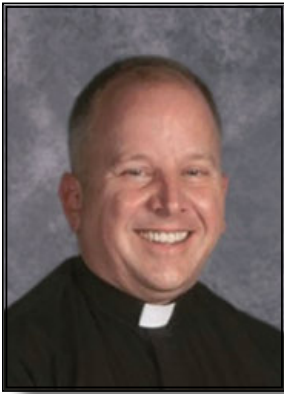

## FROM THE DESK *of* FR. DAN SHAUGHNESSY, PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are now in the Easter Season and I daresay a Season of Abundance! May the joy of the Risen Christ be with you each and every day. This is a very exciting time in Imperial!

With that said, St. Joseph will be forming a pastorate with St. John the Beloved in Imperial, at the direction of Archbishop Rozanski. After an initial meeting with the Key Parish Leaders from both parishes, we truly believe that we will be better together. We at St. Joseph look forward to working with the leadership of St. John so that we might serve the people of both St. John the Beloved and St. Joseph in Imperial, those throughout Jefferson County, the Archdiocese of St. Louis and the Universal Church. Might we all be disciples making disciples for Christ Jesus?

And beyond, we will be celebrating Family Fest on May 6<sup>th</sup>. It will be an awesome event. Please invite your family, neighbors and friends. In addition, our renovated and rebuilt Wiles Field complex in Barnhart is up and running. Seeing all of the kids and families getting outside for sports and physical fitness as a faith community is really awesome.

**\*\*\* Per the Archdiocese of St. Louis, any capital projects need to wait until the moratorium on capital projects has been lifted. That said, we received special permission from the Archbishop to complete the Wiles Field project due to health and safety concerns along with lack of usage due to grading and ground water issues. And so, the expansion of our Early Childhood program will need to wait for construction to commence until after Pentecost, May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023. The design is complete and we are ready to go. We simply need to wait for final approval from**

### **Archbishop Rozanski and the Office of Building and Real Estate. \*\*\***

Beyond that, the expansion of our Early Childhood program (Jr. K and Pre-K3); to allow more room in our growing school community) is really exciting; again, please share the good news with family, neighbors and friends. So long as we continue to have space, we welcome new students and families to both our St. Joseph School and St. Joseph PSR programs. In addition, the expansion of the Early Childhood program will also allow our St. Joseph Youth Ministry program (Middle School 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> and High School 9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup>) to continue growing and serving our young people.

Some of you have asked thoughtful questions about moving the rectory to the residence the parish owns at 1826 Valley Ridge Dr. in Imperial so that we can expand our St. Joseph School, PSR, and Early Childhood programs. We've heard statements like "We just renovated the buildings 5 years ago" and "Is this good financial stewardship, given the recent renovation of the buildings?" and "I hate to see the priests move off campus." Again, thank you for your questions. They are very fair. That having been said, I answer with the following thoughts, as I have carefully considered your comments with the Finance Council and trusted advisors like my spiritual director, some of my priest friends, and my Dad (my most trusted confidante):


a) Nearly every bit of construction we did 5 years ago to build the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel, the parish storage facility, the rectory kitchen, etc. would have had to be done for this project. The old parish offices and rectory were completely gutted 5 years ago with all new systems put in place; the systems will all remain and some will be further upgraded. The Eucharistic Adora-

tion Chapel and the parish storage facility will remain in place. With the Early Childhood program (Jr. K and Pre-K3) expansion, we will have to add a fire suppression system, upgrade the residential parts of the facility to an educational usage building type, remove some wall partitions and a couple of bathrooms, and add a security system with locked entry vestibules and a key fob system to ensure the absolute safest environment for our teachers and children. Very little would be wasted.

b) Regarding financial stewardship, we will gain 4 full classrooms and 1 smaller classroom for our Early Childhood program (freeing up 3 classrooms in the school building for St. Joseph School K-8); the Early Childhood program is open to anyone who wishes to be here with us at St. Joseph School, so long as we have space. In our current construction environment and after consultations with Fire Chief Jeff DeLapp, costs have shifted up a bit but we are exercising good financial stewardship.

c) As for moving just a 1/4 mile off campus, I will tell you this. I have prayed about this a lot. We are almost a stone's throw from campus. The current rectory is surrounded by the playground and the children's garden; the lower level of the rectory functions as the parish storage facility, and the Eucharistic Adoration Chapel is at the front corner of the building. We have pretty much no privacy. Living an incredibly short distance from campus will give the priests and seminarians a greatly desired bit of privacy. We love all of you deeply but I truly believe that a little space will be good for us. Currently, we are literally living above the store and there is action on campus all the time.

FINALLY, during this Season of Abundance, there will be bookmark prayer cards distributed by the ushers and in all the pews. The QR cards on the bookmarks will send you to links for registration in the parish (if you are new to the parish) or to the Our Sunday Visitor (OSV) online giving page link. During this Easter Season of Abundance, I ask that every family and individual in the parish consider signing up for online giving (if you are not a regular giver in the parish) or increase your weekly gift to the parish by 10% if you are able to do so. The parish is doing really really well but everything we are doing from serving the poor in Sr. Christine's Food Pantry to growing our educational programs to renovating

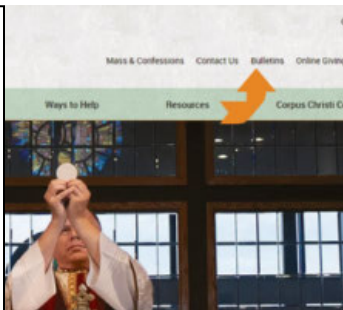

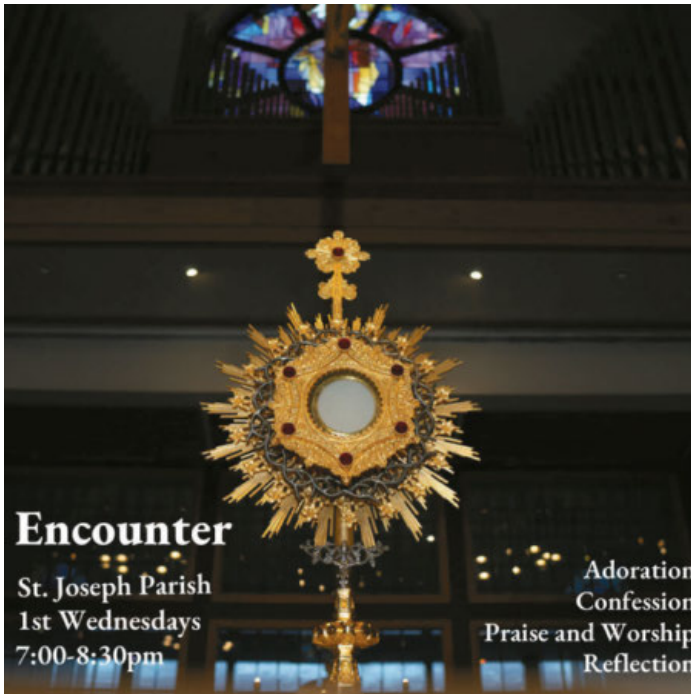
