

Dear St. Joseph Parish family,

The Sacrament of Marriage is a beautiful and powerful gift from Almighty God. When a couple calls the office and asks for Fr. Ruzicka or me seeking marriage preparation, it is a joyful occasion. We love helping to prepare couples for their married life together. The best antidote to the craziness of the world are holy, happy and healthy families.

A few trends worth noting have emerged at St. Joseph Parish over the last few years:

a) Many couples are choosing to have wedding celebrations at "destination" wedding venues, either in town or out of town. With that said, know that the Fr. Ruzicka and I regularly work with these couples to have a sacramental wedding in the Catholic Church, prior to the celebration at the wedding venue. These weddings are lovely and intimate, often attended by parents, grandparents, siblings and a few close friends. We are happy to work with you in this manner, focusing on the beauty of the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony and having a sacramental wedding before the big celebration.

b) Often times, when families register in the parish, the parish office staff will observe that the wedding of the parents may not have been witnessed in the Catholic Church. If you and your spouse desire to have your marriage validated in the Church, please contact Kathy Marlock in the parish office and she will set up a meeting for you with one of the priests here at St. Joseph to have the Convalidation.

c) And finally, as you know, the Corpus Christi Center is available for wedding receptions to parishioners and non-parishioners, Catholic or non-Catholic. 
