From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Parishioners of St. John the Beloved Disciple and St. Joseph Parishes,

As we are now nearly completing our third week of this dual-parish configuration, I thought it might be a good time to share some tips for getting the help you need and answers to your questions. As I mentioned at the Town Hall Meeting, for the most part I try to operate at the "35,000 foot" level, and St. Joseph Parish and School has a large staff upon whom I depend on to handle the details, a staff which is now available to St. John Parish as well. Of course, there are times and situations that require that I become involved, but if you can please follow the guidelines below, it will allow you to get the help you need in the most efficient way.

Starting with Saint Joseph School, there is a very specific, published protocol for student-related issues. Parents should begin with the teacher. If the concern is not settled, further discussion is needed, starting with the principal. Only after these steps are taken would I become involved. It is important to respect this protocol and if a request comes to me that hasn't followed this protocol, it will be redirected.

For parish-related issues, it is important for our St. John parishioners to be aware that the St. Joseph office hours are 7:30 am - 3:30 pm Monday through Friday. So, if you need assistance *outside* of the St. John office hours, you are welcome to call St. Joseph. This is especially true for sacramental emergencies, such as if someone needs to reach a priest for Anointing of the Sick. Outside of office hours, the St. Joseph phone system offers you an option to reach a priest immediately for this purpose.

For other issues, each parish bulletin has a staff list on page 2. The St. John bulletin includes several St. Joseph staff members who are involved in the administration of St. John in one way or another. For those of you who do use a computer, each parish website also has a staff directory: St. John: https://saintjohnimperial.org/staff and St. Joseph: https://www.sjiparish.org/staff. We understand that not everyone is comfortable using technology and we are working to find the best balance of technology and paper so that everyone feels included and informed.

If you are unsure where to direct a request or concern, please start with the main number for the School (636-464-9027), St. John Parish (636-296-8061), or St. Joseph Parish (636-464-1013) and our staff members will be happy to help.

I ask everyone's continued patience as we all work together to listen, learn, and grow within this new parish model. I truly believe that starting months ago with the key parish leaders at both parishes, and now the involvement of boards and councils and parishioner input, that we have started out on the right foot and have established a foundation that will support us as we move forward together.




