## From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

St. Joseph Parish and now St. John the Beloved Disciple Parish will be partnering (again) this year with Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in the formation of seminarians, as they assume roles in parish ministry during the academic year. The role of formator is one that Fr. Ruzicka and I take very seriously; we know that the parishes will continue to take their roles in formation very seriously, as well. And new to our team this year is Msgr. Greg Mikesch but he certainly is not new to formation. He served many years as a formator at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary, most recently as Director of the Pre-Theology program.

During the 2023-24 academic year, we will have a total of 3 seminarians serving in ministry at St. John the Beloved and St. Joseph. In addition, there will be 2 Theology III seminarians serving at St. Pius X High School (under Fr. Ruzicka's direction). Introductions as follows:

1) Our Transitional Deacon for the coming year will be Rev. Mr. Ryan Martire from the Diocese of Bismarck, North Dakota.

Growing up in Bismarck, Seminarian Ryan Martire gained a strong foundation for his faith through years of Catholic education and as a member of the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit. After his parents' divorce during grade school, to cope with the major life change, he



thought his focus should be sports. But he eventually learned that only faith could fill the void. It was in fulfilling his dream to play Division 1 soccer at DePaul University in Chicago where his true vocation came into focus. While there, he connected with the Missionaries of Charity (Mother Teresa Sisters) regularly serving at their soup kitchen. He said the sisters were a constant encouragement to his vocation to the priesthood.

After years of formation at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis, Ryan's path became clear. "I am very grateful to God," Ryan expressed. "Every year of formation has been unique and full of grace. Each year has drawn me closer to Jesus Christ and helped me to grow in my humanity in many ways. God has provided many necessary graces of healing to prepare me to serve the people of God during my time in seminary. I have come to a deeper acceptance of myself as a beloved son in the Father which gives me greater confidence to serve the diocese authentically. The journey has not been too slow, nor too fast, and the diaconate ordination comes at the perfect time." Feel free to let Deacon Martire know how his preaching is this year! That's part of your job.

- 2) The 2 Theology III seminarians, serving at St. Pius X High School, under Fr. Ruzicka's direction are Will Targy and Brian Hula, both from the Archdiocese of Omaha in Nebraska.
- 3) Our Theology II seminarian will be Jacob Miller from the Diocese of Lafayette in Indiana. His focus will be on the Pastoral Care of the Elderly, Sick and Dying which can take place in a variety of settings, including Homebound



Ministry, and the visitation of Hospitals and Nursing Homes within the parish. In addition to his presence at weekend liturgies, he will spend 3-4 hours of apostolic service each week in the parishes. Jacob wrote the following:

"I attended Wabash College in Crawfordsville and there began to seriously consider the priesthood after getting involved in the Newman Catholic Center and meeting Father Christopher Shocklee. I graduated in May of 2019 with a Religion major and Biology minor, and afterwards joined the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana as

a seminarian, completing my Pre-Seminary Year at St. Bernard in Crawfordsville. This past year was my first year of seminary in Pre-Theology I at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis. I loved my time learning about Our Lord and have a great desire to serve His people, fostered from my own love to share Jesus's Sacred Heart with others."

4) Our Theology I seminarian will be Trey Niesen from the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas. His pastoral focus will be in Ministry to Youth, through the parish Youth Ministry program, at St. Joseph Parish. In addition to his presence at weekend liturgies, he will spend 3-4 hours of apostolic service each week in the parishes. Trey wrote:



"I have been greatly influenced by my family, especially my parents, who have shown me the beauty of a family oriented to Christ. Many priests have guided me in my vocation including my parish priests, Fr. Dan Morris, and the priests at the St. Isidore's Catholic Student Center at Kansas State University. Also, so many friends have encouraged me in faith and helped me seek joy every day."

The parish communities of St. Joseph and St. John are so blessed to be trusted in the task of assisting in the formation of men for the Priesthood of Jesus Christ. Let us all pray for an abundance of vocations to both the priesthood and the consecrated life.






#### **RCIA 2023**


