Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We recently celebrated Gaudete Sunday. And the coming week ends with the shortest and darkest day of the year.

"It is a time of darkness, doubt, and fear. Gaudete is a Latin word meaning "Rejoice." But, it's actually worse than that: the Latin is in the imperative, so it means "You shall Rejoice!" 
