And so we should ask ourselves one of my very favorite prayers from Fr. Dolindo Ruotolo:

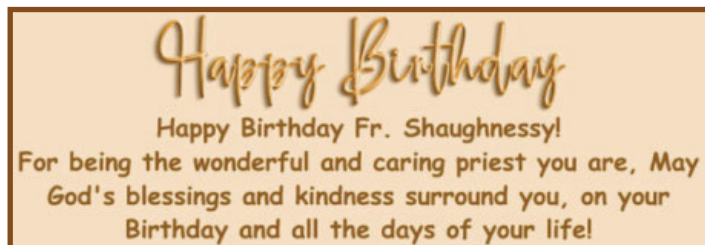
*Oh Jesus, I surrender myself to you, take care of everything!*

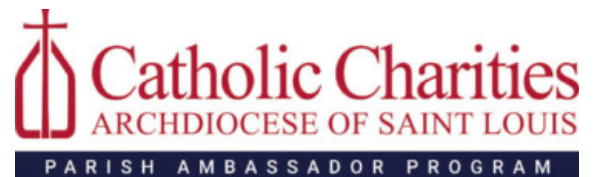
