Sacrament *of* Holy Orders and Vowed Religious Life




Lenten Program, No Greater Love: A Biblical Walk Through Christ's Passion

RCIA Rite of Sending and Rite of Election

The rite of sending is the parish celebration that sends catechumens and candidates to the cathedral for the rite of election of catechumens and of calling the candidates to continuing conversion. This rite usually coincides with the First Sunday of Lent which will be Sunday, February 18, at the 8:30 a.m. Mass.

The rite of election is the recognition of God's choice to call the catechumens for immediate initiation into the church. This rite begins the immediate preparation for the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil, March 30. This rite will take place at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis with Archbishop Rozanski officiating on Sunday, February 18, at 2:30 p.m. The rite of calling the candidates to continuing conversion will also take place at this time. We continue to pray for our elect as they prepare for the sacraments of initiation and for our candidates as they prepare for a profession of faith and the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation or the completion of their initiation.

FAST & ABSTINENCE FOR LENT

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from


