From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St. John the Beloved and St. Joseph,

Welcome to this beautiful Lenten time of year! It's hard to believe that Lent is here; it seems that we were just celebrating Christmas.

During this holy season, we have opportunities to grow in our faith-filled walk with Jesus. Lent is often a time of deepened prayer, regular fasting, and charitable works. I think many of us probably have images of what these days mean going back to our childhood. Some of these images include journeying into the desert, picking up one's cross, and offering a sacrifice of one kind or another by giving something up.

Growing up in my childhood parish, the Sisters of the Most Precious Blood at St. Monica Parish in Creve Coeur instilled in me another key image for this season: springtime. Lent is the springtime of one's soul. Given the winter that we have been enduring, with the cold weather and sunless days, I think we all are excited to welcome spring, even the springtime of one's soul. With every spring, there is something new. This is a new moment for our spiritual life. Spring also engenders many new beginnings and a wealth of opportunities. The Lenten spring is no different. In fact, the Ash Wednesday readings mark our doorway into this season, reminding us of the opportunities for spiritual growth.

Soon as well, we will be launching the Eucharistic Revival which will extend for several years, allowing us to grow deeper in authentic prayer, encountering Christ present in the Eucharist. Of all the things we pledge to do in these 40 days, prayer remains at the top of the list. I invite us all to recommit ourselves to the discipline of prayer with God and as a community of faith. In each of these opportunities we are seeking to become more intentional in our relationship with God which leads to what can be a new image of Lent for us: a springtime for the soul, nurtured by conscious intentionality, allowing us to fall more in love with Jesus who, even in our sinfulness, never tires of loving us.

With that, I might offer one suggestion for deeper prayer during Lent, namely, attending daily Mass. I remember when my parents in their early fifties (in the 1980s) decided to start attending daily Mass together as a couple. Little did I know at the time the abundant graces that would be showered on our family by their fidelity to daily prayer and reception of the Eucharist. Consider joining us for Mass every morning. It will change your life and the lives of all those around you!

Have a beautiful and prayerful Lenten season.

RCIA Rite of Sending and Rite of Election

The rite of sending is the parish celebration that sends catechumens and candidates to the cathedral for the rite of election of catechumens and of calling the candidates to continuing conversion. This rite usually coincides with the First Sunday of Lent which will be Sunday, February 18, at the 8:30 a.m. Mass.

The rite of election is the recognition of God's choice to call the catechumens for immediate initiation into the church. This rite begins the immediate preparation for the celebration of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil, March 30. This rite will take place at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis with Archbishop Rozanski officiating on Sunday, February 18, at 2:30 p.m. The rite of calling the candidates to continuing conversion will also take place at this time. We continue to pray for our elect as they prepare for the sacraments of initiation and for our candidates as they prepare for a profession of faith and the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation or the completion of their initiation.



This past Sunday, the *Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus* who serve at St. Joseph Parish and several others who serve in the St. Louis area, along with their Provincial Superior, Sr. Mary Lee, ASCJ, gathered at St. Joseph for the presentation to the Parish of a **First Class Relic of Blessed Clelia Merloni**, Foundress of the Apostles. FAST & ABSTINENCE FOR LENT

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.
