

From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Now that the Octave of Christmas and the Epiphany of our Lord have passed, we are back in Ordinary Time. As a priest, I love Ordinary Time. I love finding Jesus in the rhythm of the day in Ordinary Time. I love to celebrate the “hiddenness” of our Lord and how He constantly reveals Himself to us each and every day. We need to be vigilant. We need to be watchful but He is always with us.

And so, as we get into 2024, I am planning to pray with Peter. From today’s Gospel, we hear the call of Peter!

Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter,
was one of the two who heard John and followed Jesus.
He first found his own brother Simon and told him,
“We have found the Messiah” — which is translated Christ —.
Then he brought him to Jesus.
Jesus looked at him and said,
“You are Simon the son of John;
you will be called Cephas” — which is translated Peter.

Might we walk with Peter this year? Might we have the courage and the grace to truly follow Jesus each and every day and to give without counting the cost? To me, as a priest, the beauty of Peter is that he was a woefully imperfect; he fails all the time, and yet, he has incredible tenacity. He never gives up. With that in mind, that reminds of my favorite definition of a saint; a saint is quite simply a sinner who never gives up!

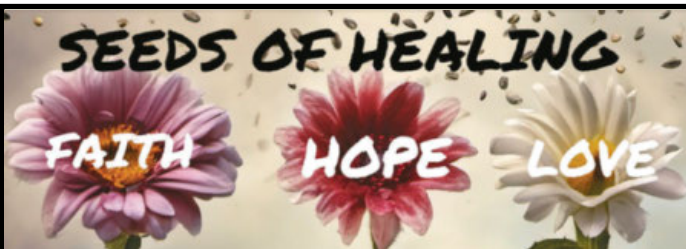
