Now that the Octave of Christmas and the Epiphany of our Lord have passed, we are back in Ordinary Time. As a priest, I love Ordinary Time. I love finding Jesus in the rhythm of the day in Ordinary Time. I love to celebrate the "hiddenness" of our Lord and how He constantly reveals Himself to us each and every day. 












Catholic Charities of St. Louis brings the healing, help, and hope of Jesus Christ to those in need with a compassionate and caring presence.
