FROM THE DESK *of*  
FR. DAN SHAUGHNESSY, PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The new year is here! And today we celebrate the Epiphany of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

I'm reminded of a trip that I took to Seville in Southern Spain in January of 2008. It was a wonderful trip marked by visits to many beautiful Catholic sites. In thinking back fifteen years ago, I was struck by the great hope and anticipation that the Spaniards displayed with the coming of the three kings, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. Parades and celebrations took place in the streets. Gifts were abundantly exchanged amongst family and friends as they emulated the three kings who brought gifts to Jesus in the manger. Culturally and liturgically, it was an awesome experience.

That said, we have a lot to learn from different cultures. And the devotion of the Spaniards to the Church (and specifically the Epiphany) was something that has stuck with me now for fifteen years.

And so, as we celebrate the Epiphany today, what gifts might we bring to Our Lord Jesus Christ in the new year? Might we promise to pray the rosary every day? If we are able, might we attend daily Mass? Might we promise to pray together before meals, as a family? Might we refrain from gossip? Might we give others the benefit of the doubt, rather than quickly casting judgment? Might we invite a relative, neighbor, or friend to join us at Mass, or in our volunteer activities? Feel free to join us this afternoon for the Festival of Ministries from 2-4 pm in the Corpus Christi Center. Over 25 different parish groups will be represented; perhaps you'll find a new opportunity to be involved!

The power of positivity and of daily, complete trust in Christ Jesus and the workings of the Holy Spirit in our lives is truly a wonderful way to live? Together, let's give it a try? If we are living pretty well, we can always do better.

Let's make 2023 a wonderful year, marked by daily praise and thanksgiving to Almighty God!

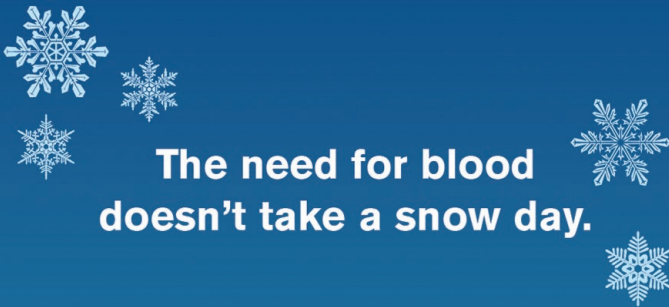

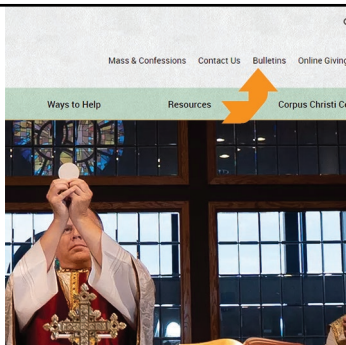
