

#### From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are living in historic times. In response to the overturning of Roe v. Wade on June 24, 2022, the parish is establishing the St. Joseph Parish Crisis Care Line. As I referenced in last week's column, we as a Catholic Christian community must work harder than ever before to support unborn children, their mothers and fathers, and all families. Every Catholic parish must ensure that women who are facing a crisis pregnancy have real and unwavering support from their communities of faith. We must make sure that adoption is a real and viable option; we must support domestic violence shelters for women and children; we must support programs and outreach for those who need assistance, providing solid postnatal care, etc.

As a result, the soon-to-be-established SJP Crisis Care Line will provide immediate consultation and services to anyone who needs support with an unplanned pregnancy, reproductive loss, or parenting resources.

The Mission of the SJP Crisis Care Line will follow the words Matthew 1:24, following the example of St. Joseph. "When Joseph awoke, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took his wife into his home." So too, the SJP Crisis Care Line will welcome those who are struggling into our home, the Church, for help.

Once established, this initiative will provide ways to communicate with the crisis care team directly. They will offer resources already readily available in our parish and the community, accompany them as needed, and request further assistance from the parish for resource gaps outside of the scope available. The SJP Crisis Care Line will be available 24/7 for pregnancy help, reproductive loss healing or parenting assistance with the vision of preserving and restoring families by deescalating crisis situations and supporting mothers and fathers in need with tangible and intangible support. May no one in our parish or community feel as though abortion is their only option. No one walks alone.

Know that in the past, the parish has done much of this work quietly and with little fanfare, so to speak. In light of Roe v. Wade being overturned, it became very clear that the time was right to take the services of the parish to a higher level than before.

Stay tuned for further details as they become available.

Let's all continue to pray for a culture of life.

# **Dynamic Catholic**

Did you ever notice that the scholars of the law, the Pharisees and the Sadducees always tried to make things complicated in order to test Jesus? Whenever they did this, what did Jesus do? He asked them a question, told them a simple story or gave them a simple answer. For instance, in today's Gospel reading a scholar asked Jesus how he could receive eternal life. Jesus answered, "What is written in the law?" This was a simple question for the scholar to answer correctly himself and he did. When the scholar tried to complicate it more by asking who is my neighbor, Jesus shared the story of the Good Samaritan. Many times in our lives we do the same thing as this scholar. We make things complicated without even realizing it and we search for answers that are really right in front of our faces. We search for answers from Jesus that He has really already answered for us but we missed it because we were looking for a complicated answer. As Moses shared with the Israelites in the first reading, "this command that I enjoin on you today is not too mysterious or remote for you." This week would be a great time for us to reflect on the questions, "For what answers am I searching? and "Has Jesus already answered it and I missed it?"

Archbishop Rozanski was born in Baltimore, Maryland on August 6, 1958, the first of three sons born to Alfred and Jean Rozanski. He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Baltimore at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen on November 24, 1984. He served for 20 years in several parishes in the archdiocese until 2004. He was ordained a bishop on August 24, 2004 at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen. At the time, he was the youngest bishop in the United States. Archbishop Rozanski serves on the board of Cross Catholic Outreach and is the Roman Catholic co-chair of the Polish National Catholic/Roman Catholic Dialogue, a position he has held since November 2017. He also serves on the Advisory Council of the National Association of Catholic Chaplains, the USCCB subcommittee on Hispanic Affairs and the National Catholic Partnership on Disability. Archbishop Rozanski has been supportive of Worldwide Marriage Encounter and presided at the World Marriage Day Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis in February 2022.


