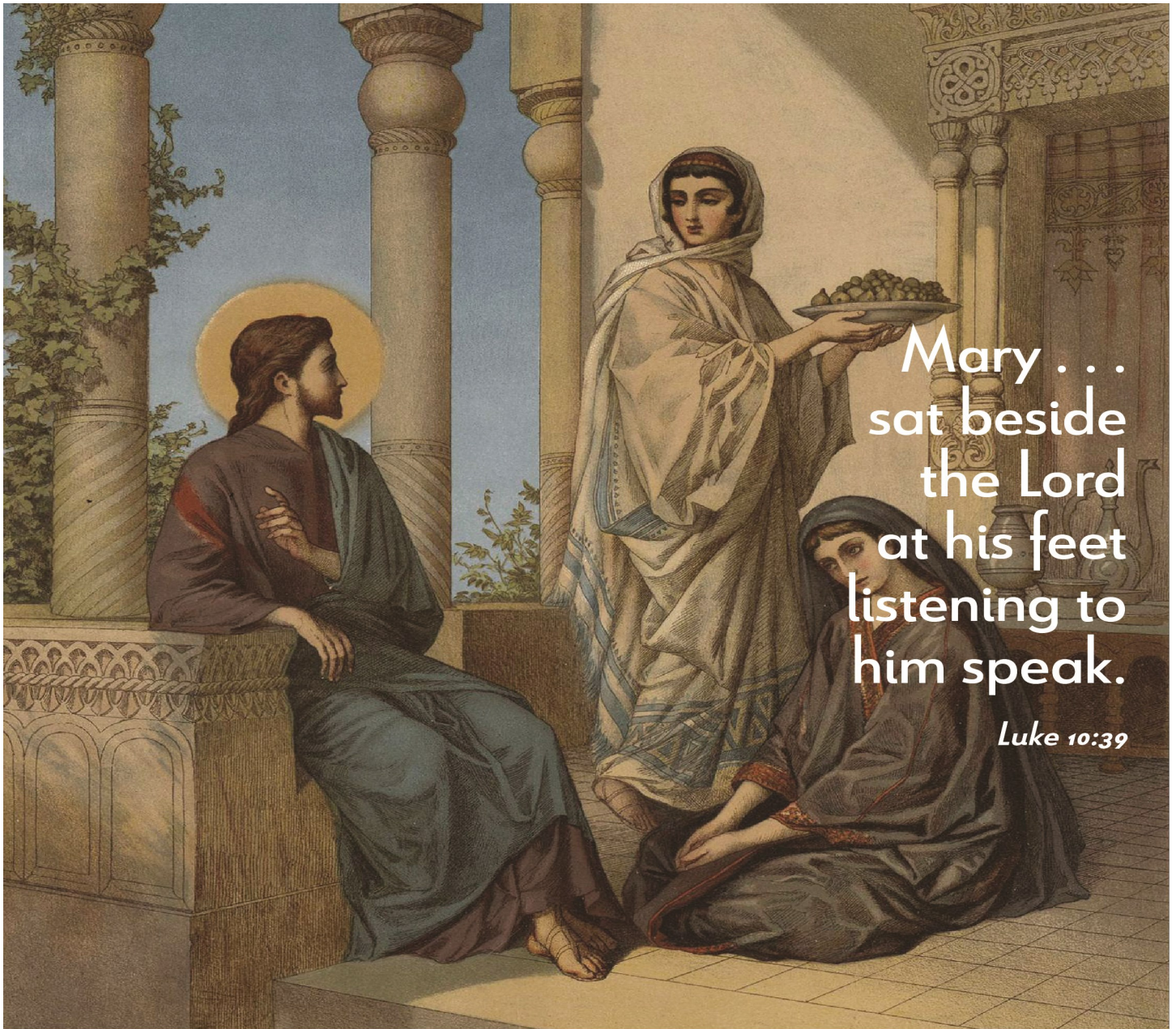

The Most Reverend Mitchell T. Rozanski has served as the 10th Archbishop of St. Louis since August 25, 2020. Archbishop Rozanski was born in Baltimore, Maryland on August 6, 1958, the first of three sons born to Alfred and Jean Rozanski. He was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Baltimore at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen on November 24, 1984. He served for 20 years in several parishes in the archdiocese until 2004. He was ordained a bishop on August 24, 2004 at the Cathedral of Mary Our Queen. At the time, he was the youngest bishop in the United States. Archbishop Rozanski serves on the board of Cross Catholic Outreach and is the Roman Catholic co-chair of the Polish National Catholic/Roman Catholic Dialogue, a position he has held since November 2017. He also serves on the Advisory Council of the National Association of Catholic Chaplains, the USCCB subcommittee on Hispanic Affairs and the National Catholic Partnership on Disability. Archbishop Rozanski has been supportive of Worldwide Marriage Encounter and presided at the World Marriage Day Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis in February 2022.
