From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It has only been a month since Archbishop Rozanski announced parish changes around the Archdiocese as a result of the *All Things New* strategic planning process, but in some ways it feels like much longer due to the pace of meetings and conversations. I thought it would be helpful to share some information on progress thus far, as well as the overall approach we are envisioning.

As you know, during the many months leading up to the Archbishop's decisions, a term we were hearing was "pastorate" but that terminology is no longer in use. As you also know, Fr. Ruzicka and I will also be associate pastor/pastor (respectively) of St. John the Beloved Disciple Parish (SJBD) as of August 1st, but both parishes retain their individual standing, meaning this is not a merger nor is SJBD being subsumed into SJP. This model creates some interesting challenges; both parishes' Key Parish Leaders (KPLs), both parishes' staffs, current SJBD pastor Fr. Richard Coerver, and Fr. Ruzicka and I have all been immersed in figuring out what all this means and how to plan our way forward.

Since both parishes will still be fully operational, we are in the process of discerning how all current practices can be managed by available staff. We will have more information on this in the coming weeks leading up to August 1st. At the outset, we are primarily approaching things with a "business as usual" mindset with a few notable exceptions. One is that Fr. Coerver will be leaving for retreat on July 11th, so SJP will take over the publication of the SJBD bulletin as of the July 16th issue. It is anticipated that within a few months, we will produce just one bulletin for both parishes. The other exception is that we have in-house staff to manage finances, so the finances for SJBD will be managed by SJP, but will be kept totally separate.

In an ongoing process, and especially once August 1st passes, we will continue to assess practices and policies and determine what needs to be done to give structure to this new paradigm. It is a learning curve for everyone involved but I am pleased and gratified to report that all communications have been open and honest and there is mutual respect in understanding that we all need to remain patient while we figure it all out!

Volunteers: Registration Required in the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Program, Prevent & Protect

St. Joseph Parish follows the Safe Environment program of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese is required to register in this system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new on-line training modules on abuse reporting, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. 


