# From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear St. Joseph Parish family,

Thanks to all of you for everything. To note, the parish response to the Season of Abundance is going very well. To date, we have raised \$241,940. Thank you. Thank you. The more we raise, the less debt we will incur.

As we move forward with the implementation of *All* Things New into this multi-parish reality in Imperial, I want to share my thinking as we move forward. This thinking has been borne as the result of conversations with many pastor friends who are stepping into far more challenging situations than ours. We have been extremely blessed, to put it mildly. I want you to know how blessed both St. John the Beloved and St. Joseph are to have Mass schedules that are largely untouched. Granted, as your pastor, it has always been my desire to offer the sacraments as frequently and readily as we are able. But still, know that this is a HUGE blessing for both parishes. Please don't take it for granted as the parish staff (along with the priests) has been working feverishly to make everything work for the Imperial communities.

And so, moving forward, I have some requests to each and every one of you:

- 1) Please commit to 15-30 minutes of daily prayer for the Church at large and for the St. John the Beloved and St. Joseph Parish communities and all their ministries. Please pray for your priests as we are taking on many new responsibilities and challenges. We are happy to take them on but we need your prayers.
- 2) Please commit to Sunday Mass, as so many of you already do. This is critical. Practically, the Archdiocese watches Mass counts closely and makes decisions as such. Sacramentally and spiritually (and far more importantly, I might add), the graces we receive when

we partake in the Eucharistic sacrifice together as a multi-parish community are immeasurable. As a community, we need to give praise and thanks to Almighty God at Sunday Mass. He commands us to do so in the 3rd Commandment when he clearly states to us, "Remember to keep holy the Sabbath day."

- 3) St. Joseph Parish is growing rapidly (athletic fields project, preschool project, etc.) and we need your added financial support. If everyone could increase their current Sunday giving by 10%, that would make a HUGE impact. And if you do not currently give on Sundays at Mass, maybe start at \$10/week. If everyone in the parish did this, again, it would make a HUGE impact. To note: if you currently give online or would like to start online giving, please visit osvhub.com/sjiparish/funds.
- 4) Tell a friend about St. John the Beloved or St. Joseph Parishes. The Catholic Church in Imperial, MO, is alive and well. We are always welcoming new families. Tell them about St. Joseph School. Tell them about Little Friends of St. Joseph preschool. Maybe one of the new families in either parish will be a neighbor, coworker or friend of yours?

### **Announcement Regarding Mass Intentions**

As you will note if you refer to the **Interim Schedule of Services** at the left, although the Mass schedule is only minimally impacted at St. Joseph Parish, there are ramifications for Mass intentions that have already been scheduled. If you have requested a Mass that is impacted by these schedule changes, we will reach out to you to reschedule.

There are two situations that will require changes. The first is that we will no longer offer a Monday morning 8 am Mass. However, we will be adding a Wednesday evening 6:30 pm Mass. Those who hold Mass intentions for Monday at 8 am will be offered the Wednesday 6:30 pm the same week, or can choose from any other available opening.

The second situation is, you may or may not be aware that Canon Law requires a pastor to celebrate a Pro Populo Mass, a Mass "for the people" on each Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation. As of August 1, Fr. Dan Shaughnessy becomes pastor of St. John the Beloved Disciple Parish in addition to pastor of St. Joseph Parish. Canon Law stipulates that a *single* Mass satisfies the pastor's obligation to celebrate a Mass for all parishioners. As a result, changes will need to be made to some already-scheduled Mass intentions as we create a Pro Populo rotation between the two parishes. What this means is you may have already booked a Mass intention that needs to be moved. If you have a scheduled Mass at a time that is designated to be a Pro Populo Mass, you will be able to accept the exchange with the former Pro Populo Mass time. Parish Administrative Assistant Rachel Schoenberger will help you understand your options.

### WHAT IS AN ACOLYTE?

In the Roman Catholic Church a person is installed in the ministry of Acolyte in order to assist the deacon and the priest in liturgical celebrations, especially the Eucharistic Liturgy. You may have noticed an extra person serving at the altar at some of the Masses the last couple of months. Dan Darian, a St. Joseph parishioner, is one of 15 men entering their 5<sup>th</sup> year of diaconate formation for the Archdiocese of St. Louis. All received the Rite of Acolyte in May of this year and will be ordained to the Permanent Diaconate in June of 2024. Please pray for these men in the diaconate formation and for all vocations.
