

And so, I wanted to share with all of you that in the spring, the Archdiocese approved safety and maintenance upgrades to our athletic fields. They were approved due to the fact that the newly installed road, sewers and future planned developments (around Wiles Field) raised the grades around the fields; these improvements were causing flooding, etc.

To the right is a current progress picture of the field renovations going on at Wiles! We can't wait to see kids back out on the fields after everything is completed in the fall.

Know too that the lighting of Wiles will be a future project; we had to plan for the construction in two phases as projects cost money.

In addition, I wanted to take this opportunity to thank many of our long-time parishioners (and most especially Mary Wiles) who made our athletic fields happen many years ago. The newly updated fields will be perfectly graded and outfitted with new backstops, fencing, etc. We had to lose some trees to make the fields regulation size but we still have many beautiful trees surrounding our fields.

Thanks to all of you for being such wonderful stewards of our incredible parish community! It is my privilege to serve as your pastor.


