From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I want to share some Information with all of you concerning the reestablishment of the Ministry of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist. We will be commencing a multi-week process shortly to reinitiate this ministry. This is a ministry that we have not seen since before the pandemic.

We are pleased and excited to restore the Ministry of Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist and the optional reception of the Blood of Christ. We are planning to restore these practices on Sunday, October 1, 2023, the feast of St. Therese of Lisieux, who was so devoted to the Blessed Sacrament. Before we can do this, however, we are inviting parishioners to apply for the ministry if you are capable and feel qualified. The Directives for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion of the Archdiocese of St. Louis states:

"Communion Ministers need to possess a love of the Eucharist and be living lives consistent with the teachings of the Church. Their role is not to be visibly confused with the distinct roles of others such as the deacon, reader,

cantor or servers. In order to keep the ministries distinct, those who have served in both the ministries of the

Eucharist and of lector may choose one ministry."

The Archdiocesan directives continue: "All ministers need to be properly trained in both the practice and the theology of their ministry before beginning. Communion is to be distributed according to the correct liturgical norms and with due reverence to the Blessed Sacrament."

Once the applicants are chosen (by parish leadership) and approved by Archbishop Rozanski, we will have training sessions and a commissioning service before October. Stay tuned for more details as the weeks unfold. Sr. Rosemary Buttice, ASCJ, will be handling the process, working closely with me and Fr. Ruzicka.

Thanks in advance for your patience and your prayerful support of St. Joseph Parish.

The message below was sent to parishioners of St. John the Beloved Disciple parish and is shared here for informational purposes.

Dear St. John the Beloved Parish family,

After a flurry of meetings on campus at St. John the first couple weeks of June, Fr. Ruzicka and I are very excited to start imagining what parish life between the two parishes will be. Know that we will officially be joined by Msgr. Greg Mikesch on August 1st, 2023. If we have not met you yet, know that we are very excited to get to know you.

Due to a variety of commitments, even though I know that many of you would like for us to start offering Mass at St. John before August 1st, in reality, that unfortunately is just not going to happen. Fr. Ruzicka and I have a whole variety of personal and pastoral commitments throughout late June and the whole month of July. We want to have a sustainable and consistent Mass schedule in place before we get started. Hence, we don't want to start one weekend and then not be back for 2 or 3 weekends, only to then start up again in August. I'm sure that you understand.

In the meantime, I am writing this letter on June 19th. I am away until June 25th on an annual vacation that I take with some priest friends. It's good to get away and to have some time to pray and ponder, all the while hanging out with brother priests. I think our Lord Jesus Christ has great things in store for the Catholic Church in Imperial.

So, to bring you up to speed on what the transition timeline will look like with Fr. Coerver departing on August 1st, I share the following:

On July 7th, 8th and 9th, Fr. Ruzicka and I will be accompanying our youth group to the Steubenville Conference in Springfield, MO, at Missouri State University.

From July 10th to July 17th, Fr. Ruzicka will be out of town on a family vacation.

From July 11th to July 22nd, Fr. Rich Coerver will be away on retreat.

On a July evening to be determined, we will be hosting a town hall meeting at St. Joseph in the Corpus Christi Center. All are welcome to attend. This will be a time to ask your priests about the future of the St. John the Beloved and St. Joseph parish communities. It will also be a time to offer dreams and suggestions about what the Imperial Catholic community might look like in the coming months and years.

From July 21st thru 24th, I will be out of town visiting family. And then the next week, we begin our combined parish Mass schedules. I have a feeling that this summer is going to be a blur!

Volunteers: Registration Required in the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Program, Prevent & Protect

St. Joseph Parish follows the Safe Environment program of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, **Prevent and Protect STL.** Everyone (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese is required to register in this system. This mandate includes parents of schoolchildren who wish to chaperone field trips or participate in other in-school activities. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new on-line training modules on abuse reporting, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct.
