From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear St. Joseph Parish Family,

Anyone who spends any amount of time on our parish campus can see it tends to be a very busy place, from first thing in the morning with early Mass and school drop-offs, into the evening with meetings in the Corpus Christi Center and elsewhere. This is never more true than on Thursday mornings throughout the year when *Sr. Christine's Food Pantry* operates the weekly food distribution. Recently some of the newer food pantry volunteers wondered, who was the food pantry's namesake, Sr. Christine?

Sr. Christine Libonati, ASCJ was a member of the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus who throughout her 50 years of active ministry served in several St. Louis-area ministries, including St. Joseph Parish in Kimmswick. In addition to running the CCD program (now known as PSR), she was instrumental in the foundation and operation of the original "Helping Hands Food Pantry." Sr. Christine retired to Sacred Heart Manor in Hamden, Connecticut in 1996. "The Manor," as it is known informally, is the retirement home for the Apostles and is located in Hamden, CT, where the Apostles have their United States Provincialate.

The Apostles were founded in Italy by Blessed Clelia Merloni in 1894 and first came to the U.S. in 1902 when a band of six Apostles landed in Boston to serve the Italian immigrants there. They taught catechism during the day, adult education classes in the evening, and engaged in hospital ministry.

In 1906, six Apostles of that growing community traveled to New Haven, CT, where they operated an orphanage, a school, and a novitiate. Decisions as to where to expand the province were governed largely by the location of Italian immigrants who could be served by the sisters. By 1913 they had made it to St. Louis, where for the last 110 years they have served in dozens of parishes and schools.

During the time when Sr. Christine and other Apostles were ministering at St. Joseph Parish, they previously lived on Montebello Camp Road, down the road from the St. Joseph Cemetery. For years they ran a preschool at that location, and later a center for day retreats.

Several years ago, the Sisters who currently serve at St. Joseph Parish and School moved into a residence closer to the Parish campus. Presently, five



Apostles are in ministry at St. Joseph: Sr. Catherine Antinora, Sr. Rosemary Buttice, Sr. Ellen Cronan, Sr. Carol Sansone, and Sr. Patricia Young. As a parish we are blessed and grateful to be the ongoing beneficiaries of Apostle service!

Easter hams needed for Sr. Christine's Food Pantry



Archdiocesan Lenten Regulations

The Church has always helped us fulfill these words of Jesus by prescribing very definite penance for all Catholics, so that we too might have Eternal life. Accordingly, the Pope and the American Bishops have outlined obligatory fast and abstinence as follows: Ash Wednesday (February 22, 2023), all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday (April 7, 2023) are days of abstinence (refraining from meat) for all Catholics from age 14 onwards. On these two days, fast, as well as abstinence, is also obligatory for those from the ages of 18-**59**. Abstinence means refraining from meat. Fast means one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted). No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation.








Immersed in the Mystery of God


