

# From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St. John the Beloved Disciple Parish and St. Joseph Parish,

Lent is upon us. It's a most wonderful time of year as we embrace the penitential nature of the season and ask Jesus how He is asking us to grow! With that said, as we look forward to the liturgies of Holy Week and the Triduum (and after Parish Council meetings at both parishes), I have some things to share:

- a) At St. Joseph, we have recently begun offering the Eucharist under both species at the Sunday Masses. St. John parishioners have expressed a similar desire. And so, on the weekend of March 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, we will begin offering Holy Communion under both species at the weekend Masses.
- b) For the Holy Triduum, the schedule of Holy Week services will be as follows:

#### St. Joseph:

Holy Thursday - 7:00 pm Good Friday - 7:00 pm Easter Vigil - 8:00 pm Easter Sunday: 7, 8:30, 10, and 11:30 am

#### St. John the Beloved Disciple:

Holy Thursday - 7:00 pm Good Friday - 3:00 pm Easter Vigil - 8:00 pm Easter Sunday - 9:00 am

c) On Divine Mercy Sunday, April 7, we will be having our primary liturgy and confessions at 2pm at St. John.

The schedule is as follows:

4:00 pm: Eucharistic Celebration

2:00 pm: Adoration (Simple Exposition) during confessions.
3:00 pm: Talk on the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Hour of Divine Mercy
Sing/pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet
Benediction

d) And during the Eucharistic Revival with a committee for both parishes being led by St. John parishioner Kathy Politte.

#### RCIA SCRUTINIES

On the second, third, and fourth Sundays of Lent the scrutinies will be celebrated here at the 8:30 am Mass. A *scrutiny* is one of the rites of the RCIA that involves self-searching and repentance. The purpose of the scrutinies is to strengthen the person to overcome temptations and to be strong in choosing what is upright and to be strong in choosing what is upright and in following the Gospel.

After the readings and homily at the Liturgy the presider invites the elect and the assembly to silent prayer and the intercessions for the Elect follow. The presider pronounces the exorcism. The exorcism is addressed to Christ, asking him to drive out the power of evil and replace it with the Holy Spirit. During the 8:30 am Mass on these days, the readings will be from the Gospel of John: the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus.
