From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The Harvest Gala at St. Joseph Imperial on Saturday night, September 23rd, was totally awesome. Not only was it an incredible fundraiser (we grossed \$183,000) but more importantly, it was a beautiful display of the fullness and the joyfulness of the Body of Christ here at St. Joseph Parish. We are so grateful for each and every one of you who made the event such a great success.

That said, and more importantly, let's look at the words today from the 21st Chapter of Matthew. Let's dig into what Jesus is trying to tell us. I daresay that in these continued interactions between Jesus and the priests and elders in the temple, "Jesus is comparing them (the priests and elders) to the second son who says yes but then does not follow through with his promise.

(Conversely), the tax collectors and prostitutes who were the very people rejected by society at the time were in fact destined for the kingdom of God ahead of those who believed they were entitled because of their position in society. Which son am I in my interactions with others and in following God's will? Do I say yes but then change my mind and do nothing or do I say no at first but after thought and prayer reconsider my decision?"






