FROM THE DESK *of*
FR. DAN SHAUGHNESSY, PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We are now three months into the implementation of parish changes as a result of the *All Things New* strategic planning process in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. As we announced in July in advance of the August 1 implementation, the Mass schedules at both St. Joseph Parish and St. John the Beloved Disciple Parish (SJBD) had minimal changes. I thought it best to adopt a “wait and see” approach, particularly with regard to SJBD, since I had no first-hand knowledge of any aspect of parish life there, spanning commitments from the Mass schedule, to Adoration, to meetings, to other things that come up in the life of a parish.

In the ensuing weeks, we—both clergy and parish staff—have become immersed in the reality of a two-parish structure. And it has not been without its challenges. St. Joseph is a much-larger parish with a large staff; St. John had been accustomed to their Pastor being there at all times, with only a few part-time staff members. As we’ve gotten to know more about them, we have been working diligently on incorporating best practices and establishing an overall structure and schedule that works for everyone involved.

With some time for first-hand observations behind us, within the last few weeks I came to the difficult decision that, as I had been told by Fr. Rich Coerver, the former SJBD pastor, the Sunday Mass attendance did not warrant two Sunday Masses. So, we emailed/published in the bulletin a survey asking parishioners if they would prefer to keep the Sunday 7:30 am Mass, keep the 10 am Mass, or instead of either of those, add a 9 am Mass. The 9 am Sunday Mass was the choice by a large margin. On Sunday, November 5, that change goes into effect.

There are other changes as well, both at SJBD and at SJP. At SJBD, the Thursday 6:30 pm Mass is moving to 8 am and there will be no confessions. There will be no Mass at 8 am on Friday. At SJP, we *had* added a Wednesday 6:30 pm Mass, but that too has been eliminated from the schedule. Of course, all these changes will be reflected in the bulletin and on the websites.

The harsh reality behind these decisions is that we need more priests, and I say that in the global sense. Let us all pray for vocations to the priesthood and of course, to consecrated life as well. As I have said over and over of late, we (Fr. Ruzicka, Msgr. Mikesch, and I) are doing the very best we can in managing the weight of multiple commitments. I simply ask that you pray for your priests and all priests. Navigating a post-*All Things New*-reality is challenging but I truly believe that Our Lord is allowing us to grow through all of this so that the Church may be stronger and healthier and more rooted in the Eucharist as we move forward!

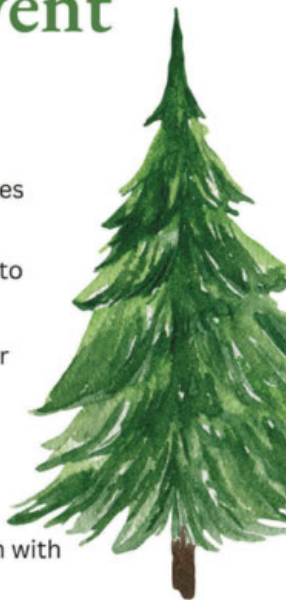

GIFT CARDS ARE DUE NOVEMBER 27th

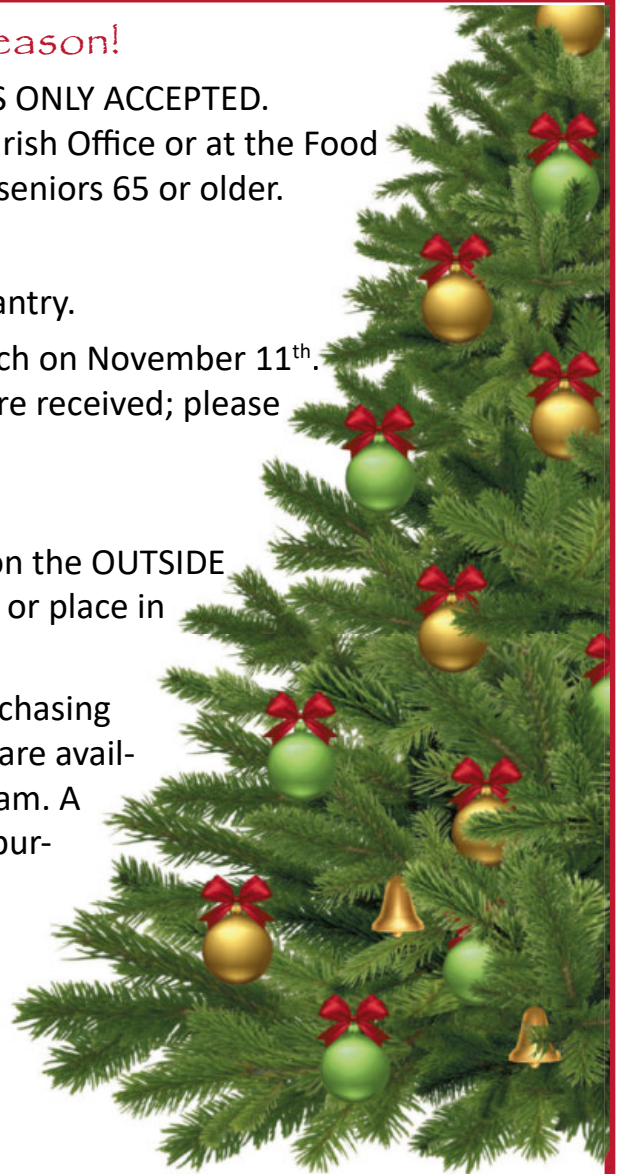

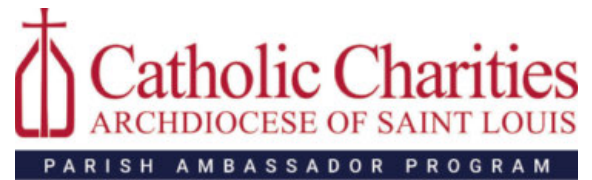
