FROM THE DESK *of*
FR. DAN SHAUGHNESSY, PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St. Joseph,

All of the passages in Sacred Scripture, about us mere mortals being like sheep and Jesus being the Good Shepherd, are both comforting and challenging. Comforting? Yes, they are comforting because sheep are one of the dumbest animals in the pasture and that (at least to me) is quite consoling. Challenging? Yes, it is also challenging because I want to make sure that I am able to hear the voice of the shepherd.

What does it look like to be a good shepherd? As we know, a good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep. A powerful image, no doubt! Who are those people in your life, willing to lay down their lives for another? My parents would no doubt lay down their lives for any one of their seven children. Are you giving yourself the luxury of quiet time with Jesus to listen? Tune out the world and tune in Almighty God.

These are important questions to ponder this week and always, for that matter. May God bless you all.

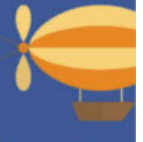
