## From the Desk *of* Fr. Jonathan Ruzicka, Associate Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St. Joseph,

Our lives move in the direction of our strongest thoughts.

If we're honest, our lived experience is powerfully dominated by the thoughts that captivate our imagination. If I believe I'm "not enough," I will live with a perpetual heaviness. If I believe I'm "unlovable," I will isolate myself and refuse intimacy and vulnerability with others. If I believe my worth comes from what I accomplish or how productive I am, I will feel worthless if I'm unproductive or if my project falls apart.

Some questions to ponder: What do you think about yourself? Does that need to be redeemed? What are the thoughts, especially the negative ones, that seem to live rent-free in your head?

The Good News has something to say about this.

Our second reading is from the First Letter of St. John. I want to highlight my favorite verse from that passage: "Even if our hearts condemn us, God is greater than our hearts" (1 John 3:20).

Søren Kierkegaard, a 19<sup>th</sup> century theologian and existential philosopher, has a beautiful discourse where he reflects on this verse. He writes: "[St. John] does not say that God is greater than the most loving human being, but that he is greater than the heart that condemns itself. God and the human being resemble each other only inversely. ... The broken heart that condemns itself seeks in vain to find an expression that is strong enough to describe its guilt, its wretchedness, its defilement – God is even greater in showing mercy! ... As deep as this heart can lower itself, so infinitely

more elevated is God's greatness in showing mercy! ... Even the most compassionate word that the most compassionate inwardness is able to think up would sound to this heart, which would not dare and would not allow itself to be comforted, like a new condemnation upon it – so infinite is God's greatness in showing mercy. ... God is greater than your own heart!"

Our hearts can often be masters of melancholy and self-reproach. Jesus has come to give us a new heart. Fr. Almire Pichon, the spiritual director of St. Thérèse of Lisieux, once wrote to her in a letter: "Believe obstinately that Jesus loves you." Thoughts like this ought to captivate our minds and hearts. What would our lives look like if we lived from this personal declaration statement?

If your heart condemns you, God is greater than your heart. His tender love for us is beyond words. Jesus desires to lift the heaviness of shame and self-loathing that plague our souls. He wants to give us life in abundance (John 10:10).

We humans are all too good at putting ourselves down – God is even greater in showing us mercy. Perhaps this week, we can surrender any negative thoughts and receive the truth that God reveals. "Believe obstinately that Jesus loves you."

You are His – and He delights in you.




