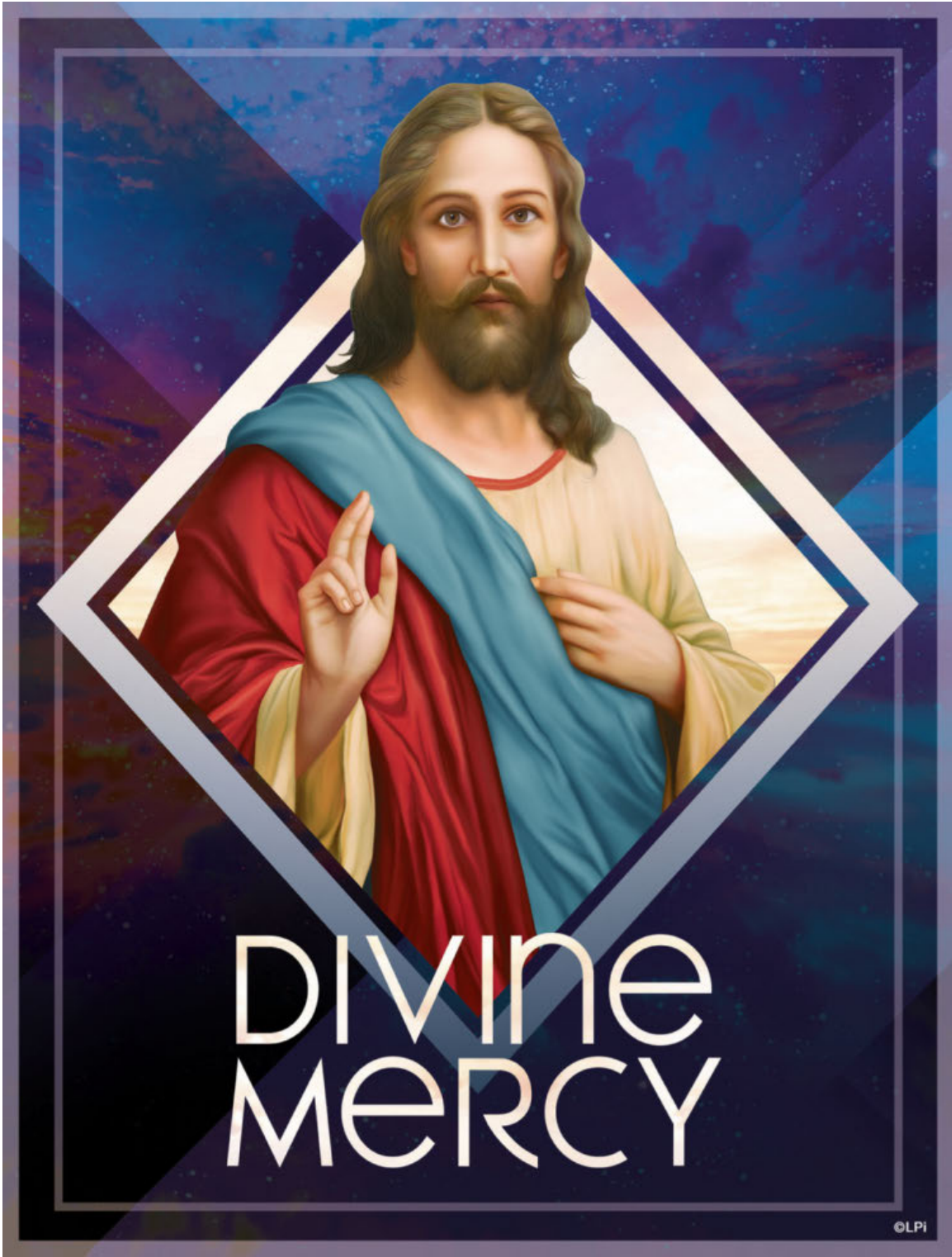

FROM THE DESK *of*
FR. DAN SHAUGHNESSY, PASTOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ at St. Joseph,

As we celebrate the joys of the Easter season, I wanted to share with all of you a springtime update of how things are going at the parish from a financial perspective. First, annual giving to the offertory collections is strong. If you look at the collections data in the bulletin from this week, you will see that we are over \$50,000 ahead of budget. This is a really big deal and is certainly not the trend at all Catholic parishes in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Thank you. The more you are able to give to the offertory collections (and at large parish fundraisers like the parish dinner auction), the more the parish is able to do to foster an environment of discipleship. If you could each increase your offertory gifts by 10%, that would make a HUGE impact in helping us in the tough inflationary environment in our country today. That said, we are SO VERY grateful to all of you for everything you are doing to support St. Joseph.

Second, we have been able to complete many important maintenance upgrades and safety improvements on campus. Most were budgeted; some were not. A partial list follows below:

- We have replaced 3 of the “small” roof top units (RTUs) on the school building. The cost of this work was \$50,000. We hope to replace 3 more next year. RTUs are involved in the heating/cooling of the building.
- We have replaced 1 of the “large” RTUs on the gym. The cost of this work was \$90,000.
- We have installed a new sound system in the gym ahead of the Aladdin production. The cost of this work was \$40,000. In the fall, we replaced the sound system in church for roughly \$20,000. The FUND A NEED at the auction raised nearly \$40,000 toward the funding of these 2 large items. Hence, the parish covered the remaining \$20,000.
- The doors into the gym from the parking lot have been upgraded with a new keyless entry system. The cost of this work was \$10,000.

The list goes on but those are some highlights.

Third, Sr. Christine’s Food Pantry is running low on funds, due to very high demand for services. Each week, we are serving roughly 110 families with large box pickups on Thursdays. There is a high demand for food and basic provisions. If you could help out by making a donation to the pantry, that would be a huge help. We need to be able to gear up for high need throughout the summer months, especially when many children are out of school for the summer. The ministry that our food pantry shepherds, led by John Balsman and Ed Herrell, is pretty awesome.

Overall, things are going very well. Enrollment in Saint Joseph School and St. Joseph PSR is strong. Middle school and high school youth ministry programs are thriving. Mass attendance is solid. Our parish office team is second to none. I could go on and on but there is only so much space in this bulletin column.

Thank you. God bless you. I am privileged to be your pastor!
