From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

You, your neighbors, your relatives and friends (in short, any registered parishioner) should have received a copy of my pastoral letter regarding Mass attendance and the importance of the St. Joseph Parish family praying together. If you think there is someone who would benefit from the letter (who did not receive one), please share it with them or else, contact Kathy Marlock in the parish office at 636-464-1013 and Kathy and I will send them a letter.

The letter was the fruit of a lot of prayer and a lot of work and a lot of patience on my part. Why patience? It's been difficult for me to wait to write the letter. To recap, the Archdiocese gave a dispensation from Mass due to Covid from March 2020 to July of 2021. Right when we thought things were winding down, the Delta variant hit in July/ August of 2021. That raged for awhile, as we all know. After that, the Omicron variant hit in December/January of 2021-22. That took several months to resolve. Then, it was summer break and now, after an exhausting and emotionally/spiritually draining 2+ years, I felt like the time for the pastoral letter finally presented itself. I hope you agree!

Fr. Ruzicka and I sincerely hope that you will share the contents of the letter with your family, neighbors and friends. Like I said in the letter, the most important thing we can do as a parish family is pray at the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Obviously, the priest leads the community in prayer but we all bring our sacrifices together to the altar. If we are not praying together as a parish family, then we need to look inward and ask ourselves some tough and introspective questions.

To recap, Mass attendance is critical for all of us!

And practically speaking, since we are in the All Things New reorganization/restructuring of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, it's going to be really important for us as a parish community to "show up," so to speak. The Archdiocese is using Mass counts, offertory numbers and demographic data to make decisions regarding allocation of resources for parish communities. Granted, that's a very pragmatic and opportunistic reason. But it's important to share that with all of you in the parish community as well.

God bless you all. Fr. Ruzicka and I are truly blessed to be your priests. Armed with prayer and love/support of each other, there is no challenge that we as a parish cannot take on together.

We are ONE in the Body of Christ.


