Grandparents, great-grandparents, aunts, uncles, friends who also serve as grandparents, what do you most want to pass on to your grandchildren?


This and other questions will form the basis of a six-week program gathering grandparents in our community for conversation. All are invited to this program "Grandparenting with Grace."


