

From the Desk *of* Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the past few weeks, there have been some powerful events to ponder! I share a few below.

On Sunday, we remembered the 21st anniversary of the 9/11 attacks on the World Trade Center, the Pentagon, and Shanksville, Pennsylvania. Personally, I remember that day like it was yesterday and I can tell you exactly where I was (and what I was doing) when the first plane hit. The attacks were horrible; abject evil. But what came out of the attacks in the days, weeks, and months that followed was pretty incredible. People came together in prayer. People came together to help each other without counting the cost, so to speak. There was a genuine spirit of unity in the face of horrible evil. Might we reclaim the spirit of those days.

On September 8, Queen Elizabeth II died after a 70+ year reign. I'm not an Anglophile and I'm certainly not much of a monarchist and I know very little about English history but her passing is significant for a variety of reasons. First, she embodied many things that the world seems to shun today; tradition, values, honor, a sense of decorum, and lifelong public service. As she said in her Christmas broadcast in December 2000: 'For me the teachings of Christ and my own personal accountability before God provide a framework in which I try to lead my life." (https://www.royal.uk/christmas-broadcast-2000) It's worth noting the extraordinary life that she lived. We all have a story, if you will. Maybe we can learn something from her example.

In closing, might we live the fullness of our faith in Christ Jesus each and every day! Might the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Mystical Body of the Roman Catholic Church, the Body of Christ Himself, guide us, strengthen us and nurture us each and every day.

Dear Friends in Christ.

The call to be deacon is to serve. On Sunday, October 2, 2022, there will be a special collection for the formation of permanent deacons in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. This collection relieves some of their financial burden for studies to become a deacon.

Since 1977, 505 men have been ordained as permanent deacons in the Archdiocese. There are 195 active deacons ordained for the Archdiocese and 87 retired deacons. There are 26 men in formation at this time.

When the permanent diaconate program was initiated in the Archdiocese in January 1977, men went through a two-year formation program, with a third year of post-ordination formation. Since then, the program has gradually expanded to five years of formation, plus five more years of post-ordination formation.

Deacons serve in parishes, hospitals, archdiocesan agencies, and other organizations. They offer their time, talent and energy to strengthen our church in St. Louis and do not receive compensation for their work. Their service extends into many areas of parish life, including the proclamation of the Gospel, liturgical functions, administration, and charitable works. Many active deacons continue to be employed full-time, requiring them to balance family lives and professions with their ministry as a deacon.

All Things New Listening Sessions

Thanks to all of you who have participated in the All Things New surveys and provided data and feedback over the past few months. The information has been enlightening, educational and fruitful as we continue to ask ourselves what our parishes, ministries and institutions need to look like in order to effectively share our Catholic faith in a way that is suitable and sustainable for our children and generations to come.

The next step in this multi-year process is to hear more robustly from you, our parishioners, about our parish. The Archdiocese of St. Louis will host over 350 listening sessions throughout our 178 parishes between October 8 - November 19, 2022. More information will be forthcoming.



Parishioners must register in order to attend a listening session. Registration will close once the designated room's seating capacity is reached. There will not be additional opportunities for listening sessions other than the ones scheduled for each parish.

Each listening session, including ours, will be facilitated by volunteer parishioners from a different parish. These trained facilitators will share pre-recorded messages from Archbishop Rozanski and Fr. Chris Martin, Vicar for Strategic Planning, with an overview of All Things New, a planning area overview and multiple DRAFT model options to consider for our respective planning area. A brief time will be allowed for small group discussion and facilitated large group feedback.

The goals of the listening sessions are to engage as many of you as possible in understanding the current state of our parish and diocese and to solicit feedback from as many of you as possible about the DRAFT models options for their planning area.

After the final listening session in each planning area, the Archdiocese of St. Louis will make public the content presented at all the parish's listening sessions in that planning area and will offer an additional opportunity for parishioners to provide open-ended feedback through an online survey. The survey will remain open until December 31, 2022. Parishioner feedback to the models is critical, as it will be used to help shape the future of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

In order for you to be fully prepared with accurate information before our parish listening sessions, you will receive access to our Parish Workbook. The Archdiocese of St. Louis has created Parish Workbooks as a supplementary resource to help us prepare for the listening sessions. The workbooks are meant to equip us with data about the Archdiocese of St. Louis, our local planning area, and our specific parish. Our Parish Workbook is posted on allthingsnew.archstl.org for anyone to view.

Please continue to pray for the gift of true discernment so that we may continue to do the Will of God in all things.


Society of St. Vincent de Paul Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time
