

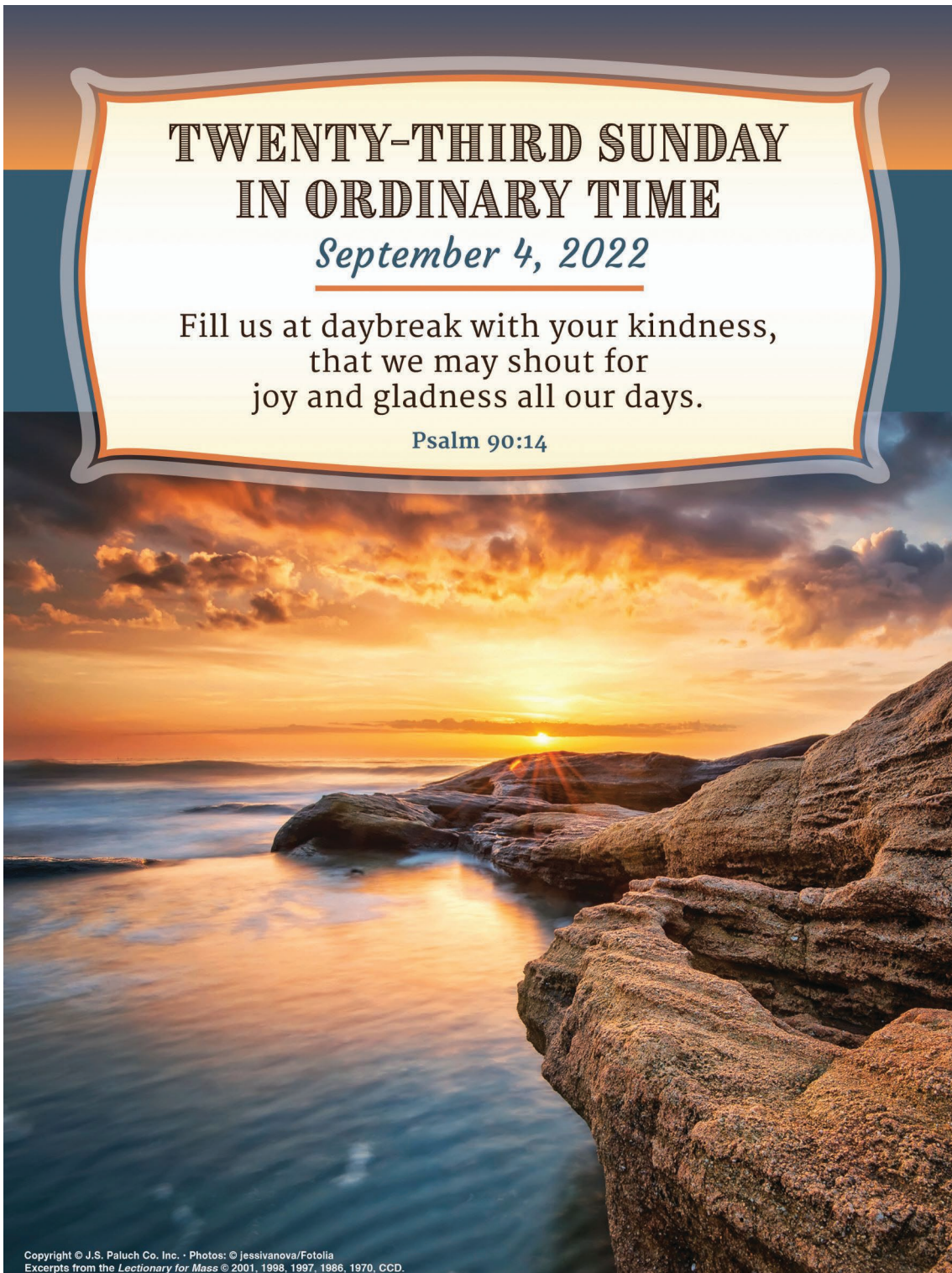

A call came in to our hotline from the Fire Department across the road from us. A firefighter told us that a homeless man approached them and said he could use some help. The man said he had walked up from Farmington over the last two days during our 100 degree or high 90s heat. He didn't have a phone so the firefighter called us.

We found the man sleeping under a tree behind the firehouse. He had absolutely nothing but the clothes on his back. He said he had nowhere to go and had no family. He was somewhat vague about some details. We were able to provide a week lodging at a local hotel. We provided him with some food, personal care items, and several articles of clothing. When asked about future plans he indicated that he had a possible lead on a temporary job with another church in the area. He said he just wanted some sort of a job and be able to care for himself. Hopefully, he will be able to do that. And we will be praying for him. As Vincentians, we are here to help as many of our Neighbors In Need as we can. Your generous donations help make this possible. 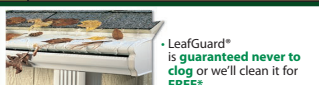
