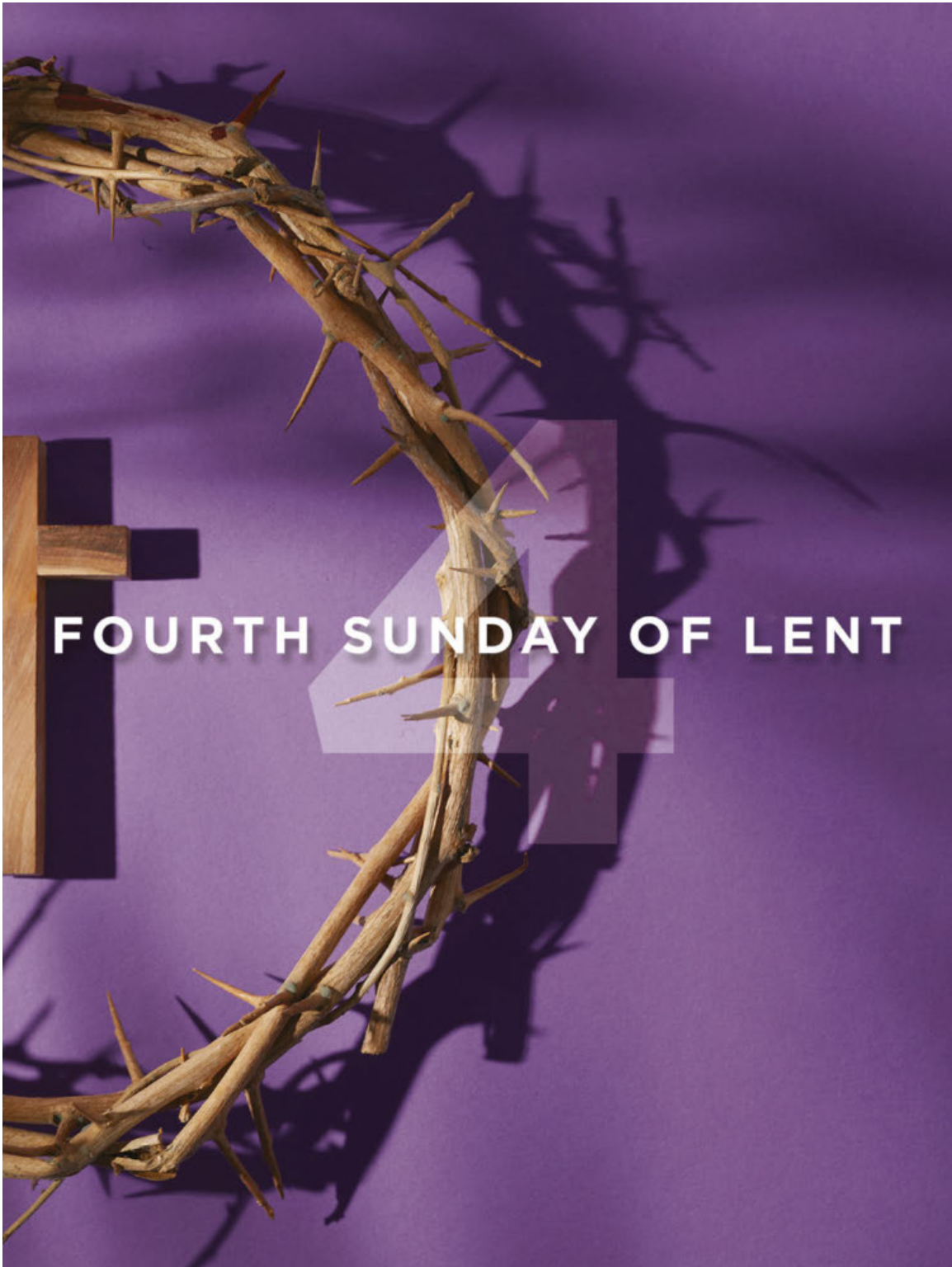



...A Journey in Faith

RCIA SCRUTINIES

On the second, third, and fourth Sundays of Lent the scrutinies will be celebrated here at the 8:30 am Mass. A *scrutiny* is one of the rites of the RCIA that involves self-searching and repentance. The purpose of the scrutinies is to strengthen the person to overcome temptations and to be strong in choosing what is upright and in following the Gospel.

After the readings and homily at the Liturgy the presider invites the elect and the assembly to silent prayer and the intercessions for the Elect follow. The presider pronounces the exorcism. The exorcism is addressed to Christ, asking him to drive out the power of evil and replace it with the Holy Spirit. During the 8:30 am Mass on these days, the readings will be from the Gospel of John: the Samaritan woman, the man born blind, and the raising of Lazarus.

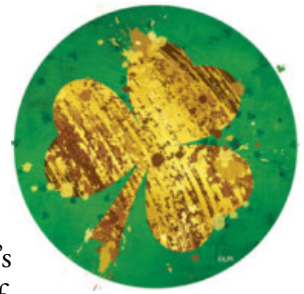
