Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

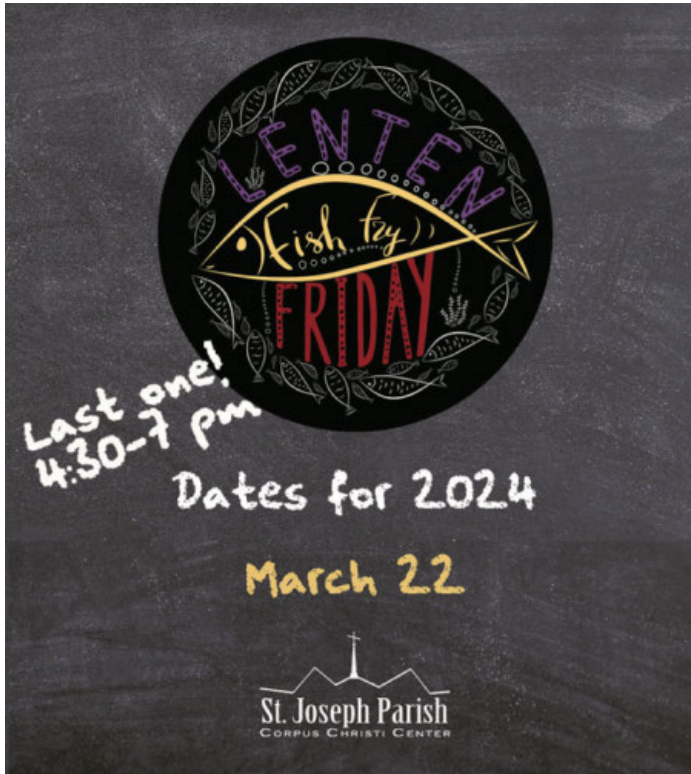
Saint Joseph School Board Elections
