Dear Parishioners,

With sad, but Grateful Hearts, we prepare to say, "see you later" to Fr. Shaughnessy in a few short weeks. Over the past 9+ years, we have witnessed our parish grow and flourish, all under Father's exceptional leadership and spiritual guidance. The St. Joseph parish family overcame growing pains, saw the rise and opening of our beautiful Corpus Christi Center, navigated through a pandemic, and grew our school programs, as well as many other accomplishments, both big and small.



Fr. Shaughnessy departs the parish at a time of continued growth and success. One of Father's goals this year was to pay down the debt and have a mortgage-burning party for the rectory. We couldn't think of a greater gift of thanks than to try to do just that, before his departure.

Many are excited to support the great work at St. Joseph, and with a generous donation of \$75,000 we already received, we are positioned to pay off the rectory debt before Father departs at the end of July. However, we need your help to cross the finish line.

With Grateful Hearts we wish to show our appreciation to Fr. Shaughnessy for his visionary leadership, in matters both spiritual and temporal, by offering an unusual but apt parting gift: let's raise \$85,000 to pay off the mortgage on the rectory. No amount is too small and all donations are appreciated. Just to put it in perspective, if each of our over-2,000 parish households expressed their gratitude for Fr. Shaughnessy's leadership with a donation of \$50 to this appeal (which is approximately \$5 for each year Fr. Shaughnessy has been at St. Joseph), we would raise \$100,000, exceeding our goal.

We hope you will be as generous as your means allow as we continue to be responsible stewards of our gifts. Your contribution will help Fr. Shaughnessy meet this goal, and he would like nothing better than to burn the mortgage during his going-away party on July 28. (More on that will follow!) 

From the Desk *of* Fr. Daniel Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This week, Father Ruzicka and I are away on a trip to Italy (Rome and Assisi) and France (Normandy, Lisieux, and Paris). It's just a brief 10-day trip but it's one that is very exciting for us both. I was last in Rome with my Mom and Dad in June 2004; that trip was very instrumental in my vocational discernment. After that trip, I was certain that the Lord was calling me to be a priest. And for Fr. Ruzicka, this is his first time to Europe; he's equally excited in a completely different way. Know that we will be praying for you all while we are overseas.

In addition, please be generous with the missionary priests from Cross Catholic Outreach (CCO), who will be with you this weekend. They do very important work, serving the poorest of the poor all throughout the world. An example of a story follows:

Clean Water Helps Priest Create 'Garden of Eden' in Semi-Arid Southern Kenya Imagine reaching the point where your children have to draw their drinking water from a stream contaminated with raw sewage.

Could it really ever get that bad? Yes it can, and we've (CCO) written at length about the severity of the water crisis Kenyan villages are facing. But today we want to focus on a victory in our battle against water scarcity because it is an achievement worth celebrating!

As part of our effort to bring relief to families caught up in Kenya's water crisis, we recently helped install deep, dependable wells in 15 Catholic parishes serving semi-arid rural communities. This brings the total number of Cross Catholic Outreach wells (with solar-powered pumps and convenient, sanitary distribution kiosks) in southern Kenya to 71. That is a transformative and hope-restoring achievement, and it happened in just five years, thanks to the generosity of our compassionate donors!



If you have not already informed the Parish Office about changes to your record, please let us know now so that the information in the Guide Book & Directory is correct.




