From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The 2023-24 fiscal year has ended and things went very well. Most importantly, we have grown as a family in faith, nourished by the Sacraments and enriched by our participation in the Body of Christ through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. What a beautiful parish community we have at St. Joseph Parish! That said, the fiscal year largely speaks to finances and we have exceeded our budgeted goals, thanks be to God. It takes money (and lots of it) to make this parish run and we are grateful to all of you for your support.

First, of course, we have the parish offertory collections.

Total collected for the 2023-24 fiscal year was: \$1,288.094.74 (an average of \$24,303.67 based on 53 Sundays) Total budgeted for the 2023-24 fiscal year was: \$1,143,144.81

Hence, we exceeded our annual budget by: \$ 144,949.93

Great job! Thanks to all of you for all you've done to support the St. Joseph Parish community.

Second, the cash in our parish accounts at First State Community Bank (FSCB) is \$326,617.90. We generally like for this number to equal 6 months of Sunday collections. So conceptually, we'd like for it to be double where it currently stands. That said, early in the fiscal year, we had projected that this number might be as low as \$125,000 on June 30, 2024. Why? We completed the \$900,000 Little Friends of St. Joseph (LFSJ) preschool building project in October, 2023. This project was essential for the continued growth of St. Joseph Parish but it put a bit of a strain on the annual finances.

Third, we have our loans:

Our first loan is the rectory loan. We are hoping to eliminate this loan with a mortgage burning party at my going away party on July 28th. The value of this loan is \$160,000. Hope you can help us out with a gift!

Our second loan is the CCC loan. The value of this loan is \$1,228,000. It is truly remarkable that we have lowered this loan so rapidly. On 12/31/2021, the balance of this loan was \$1,715,000.

Our third loan is the loan for the work at Wiles Field. The current balance on this loan is \$297,000. This loan is fully funded by the profits from the St. Joseph Athletic Association.

Our fourth loan is the loan for LFSJ. The current balance on this loan is \$447,000. This is remarkable considering that the project cost \$900,000. And this loan is fully funded by proceeds from the revenues of LFSJ.

The total of those 4 loans equals \$2,132,000. Hopefully, that will equal \$1,972,000, after the rectory mortgage burning party on July 28th!

Regardless, the value of this campus conservatively is \$40,000,000. Hence, the debt on the value of our campus is only 5% of the total campus value. Imagine if you only owed 5% of the total value of your house on your home mortgage. You'd be feeling great about things, and we should be feeling great about things too.

Fr. Yates is entering this parish at a very good time in its history. I know that you will all support him fully and happily. He is a wonderful man and an exceptional priest. Hopefully, soon into his tenure at St. Joseph, you all will be able to embark on the church renovations.








Order of Christian Initiation of Adults


81st Annual Novena to Our Lady of the Snows Sunday,7/28- Monday, 8/5 Mass 7:30 pm nightly.
