From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This is my last bulletin column with all of you. Hence, I have lots of varied things to say! Big surprise there!

FIRST, related to debt reduction and our loans, we have some exciting news to share:

Related to the rectory loan, as of July 21, 2024, we have raised over **\$120,000 toward paying down the \$160,000 balance**. Hopefully by the time you read this, we will be able to shred that mortgage.

Our second loan is the CCC loan. **The value of this loan was \$1,228,000 just a few weeks ago. As of July 22, 2024, 2 very generous donors stepped forward to reduce this loan balance to \$999,000. Remarkable. What an incredible gift.**

Our third loan is the loan for the work at Wiles Field. The current balance on this loan is \$293,000. This loan is fully funded by the profits from the St. Joseph Athletics Association.

Our fourth loan is the loan for LFSJ. The current balance on this loan is \$442,000. And this loan is fully funded by proceeds from the revenues of LFSJ.

SECOND, related to St. Joseph School (SJS) and Little Friends of St. Joseph (LFSJ), total enrollment, as of July 22, 2024, currently stands at 440 students. When I arrived at St. Joseph, this number was well below 300. Thanks to all you in St. Joseph Parish and beyond for trusting us with both the academic and religious formation of your children. It's a humble honor and privilege.

THIRD, St. Joseph Athletic Association is thriving. Driving by Wiles Fields any night and seeing all the activity down there brings me a lot of joy.

FOURTH, our Sr. Christine's Food Pantry and St. Vincent de Paul Society chapter are thriving, serving countless families in the Jefferson County region.

FIFTH, our youth ministry programs, led by Sean Feltz, are second to none. We had an awesome Steubenville weekend with our high schoolers a couple weekends ago. And we are getting ready for both LUKE 18 and Fall Retreat. The work and formation being done in these programs is awesome.

I could go on and on. But I don't have the time or space.

Most importantly, we have an incredible parish community, nourished by our commitment to prayer; to the sacraments; to being a disciple-driven community committed to sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ in a world that so desperately needs the Gospel. It has been such a privilege to shepherd this faith-filled community over these 9.5 years. It's the longest I have lived anywhere since I moved out of my folks' house in 1997. You have truly become my family. And it's tough to leave your family! But I leave here knowing that the parish is in really good hands. And I also am 100% confident that the Lord is calling me to go back to Wentzville.

God bless you all! I cannot wait to hear about all wonderful things that will happen in the coming months/years at St. Joseph Parish, under the shepherdly direction of Fr. Yates, Fr. Ruzicka and Msgr. Mikesch!

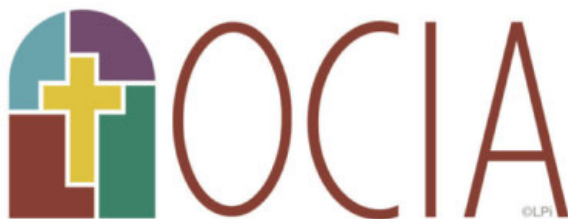

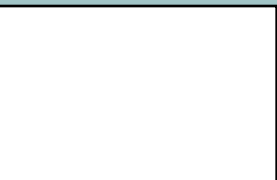
