From the Desk of Fr. Dan Shaughnessy, Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The time overseas was great. As I planned the trip in February, I had no idea what lay ahead in the coming months. Little did I know at the time that my Mom would be called home by God on April 16th. Nor did I know that the Vicar for Priests would call me on May 30th to let me know that Archbishop Rozanski was moving me to St. Patrick Parish in Wentzville. In many ways, the trip served as a kind of last hurrah for Fr. Ruzicka and me, not knowing that it would be so when I planned it. But isn't that true of life? The Lord is always many, many steps ahead of us.

The trip was very timely for me personally. It was the 20th anniversary of a trip that I took to Rome with my folks in June 2004, and it was on that trip that I realized that it was time for me to go to the seminary. I had been fighting the call for a long time and on that trip, looking back, I think I finally relented, so to speak. And thanks be to God for that. On this most recent trip, I was mesmerized by the beauty of Rome and Assisi in Italy and Lisieux in France. Having been trained as an architect prior to seminary, I found it so energizing to walk amidst the beauty of Rome and the other places we visited. Beyond that though, being overwhelmed by the history and the roots of our Roman Catholic Church was truly inspiring. The Church, although woefully imperfect, is the living, breathing Body of Jesus Christ Himself. Seeing its evolution and history in the Eternal City of Rome was awe-inspiring. WOW. I hope that you all have the opportunity to go to Rome someday.

And beyond the trip, I've had a lot of time to think about the changes coming, as I will be leaving St. Joseph Parish after 9.5 years (and St. John the Beloved after 1 year). It's difficult for me to get my head around this upcoming reality, as 9.5 years is a long time. It's the longest I have lived in one place, since I left my parents' house in 1997. And the parish communities have become my family. I'm not sure what to do with all of my thoughts and emotions.

Firstly, I guess I want to say thank you. When I arrived at St. Joseph in February 2015, I had never been a pastor before. You all were getting a rookie. And so, I thank you as you were and have been so very patient with me. I surely have made many mistakes. But through them all, you supported me and always gave me the benefit of the doubt. And I know that you prayed for me through all of my peaks and valleys. Being a parish priest has been the greatest blessing of my life. In spite of all of the challenges, I love each and every day of my life as an incredible gift from Almighty God, and know too that it truly has been a blessing to serve all of you.

Secondly, I want to encourage you. Pastors come and go (as I am learning in all humility), but parish communities rooted in Christ Jesus grow and thrive over decades and centuries, for that matter. The leaders, spiritual fathers configured as Christ Jesus (as an alter Christus), serve the parish, the Body of Christ, as a husband serves his bride. So please continue to be abundantly faithful and supportive of the parish community, as Father Yates arrives on August 1st. The parish communities of St. Joseph and St. John will grow and develop in new ways, under different leadership. Change, although difficult at times, is a good thing. As I reflect on my time here at both St. Joseph and St. John, it's important for me to realize that it was never about me personally but always about building the Body of Jesus. That's one of the many reasons that change is so good. It's both challenging and humbling in so many ways.

Thirdly and finally for now, please continue to pray for me as I depart Jefferson County in a few short weeks. I will need the prayers more than ever, as I take on the leadership of a new parish community! ALL FOR JESUS, ALL THE TIME.

Dear Parishioners,

With sad, but **Grateful Hearts**, we prepare to say, “see you later” to Fr. Shaughnessy in a few short weeks. Over the past 9+ years, we have witnessed our parish grow and flourish, all under Father’s exceptional leadership and spiritual guidance. The St. Joseph parish family overcame growing pains, saw the rise and opening of our beautiful Corpus Christi Center, navigated through a pandemic, and grew our school programs, as well as many other accomplishments, both big and small. Fr. Shaughnessy departs the parish at a time of continued growth and success.



One of Father’s goals this year was to pay down the debt and have a mortgage-burning party for the rectory. We couldn’t think of a greater gift of thanks than to try to do just that, before his departure.

Many are excited to support the great work at St. Joseph, and with a generous donation of \$75,000 we already received, we are positioned to pay off the rectory debt before Father departs at the end of July. However, we need your help to cross the finish line.

With Grateful Hearts we wish to show our appreciation to Fr. Shaughnessy for his visionary leadership, in matters both spiritual and temporal, by offering an unusual but apt parting gift: let’s raise \$85,000 to pay off the mortgage on the rectory. No amount is too small and all donations are appreciated. Just to put it in perspective, if each of our over-2,000 parish households expressed their gratitude for Fr. Shaughnessy’s leadership with a donation of \$50 to this appeal (which is approximately \$5 for each year Fr. Shaughnessy has been at St. Joseph), we would raise \$100,000, exceeding our goal.

We hope you will be as generous as your means allow as we continue to be responsible stewards of our gifts. Your contribution will help Fr. Shaughnessy meet this goal, and he would like nothing better than to burn the mortgage during his going-away party on July 28. (More on that will follow!) 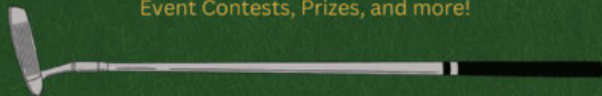

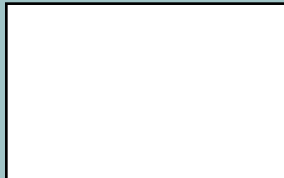
