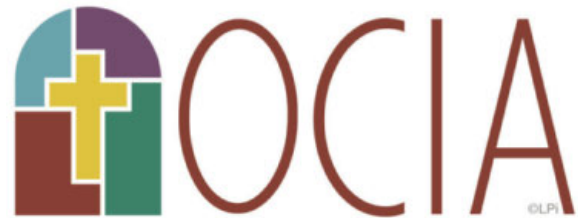

From the Desk of Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor

Vote “no” on Amendment 3

WHAT IT SAYS >>>	WHAT IT DOES
<p>1. This Section shall be known as “The Right to Reproductive Freedom Initiative.”</p>	<p>THREATENS PARENTAL RIGHTS By using “person” instead of adult or woman, anyone under the age of 18 could have an abortion or make any other reproductive decision without their parents’ consent or notification.</p>
<p>2. The Government shall not deny or infringe upon a person’s fundamental right to reproductive freedom...including but not limited to prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, birth control, abortion care, miscarriage care, and respectful birthing conditions.</p>	<p>PUTS WOMEN AT RISK Current Missouri laws require abortion providers to explain procedure risks and ensure access to hospital transfer if needed and to administer medication abortions in person in case of complications for the woman. These health and safety standards could be seen as an “interference” or “delay” and be eliminated, making it even less safe for women seeking an abortion.</p>
<p>3. The right to reproductive freedom shall not be denied, interfered with, delayed, or otherwise restricted unless the Government demonstrates that such action is justified by a compelling governmental interest achieved by the least restrictive means. Any denial, interference, delay, or restriction of the right to reproductive freedom shall be presumed invalid.</p>	<p>ALLOWS FOR ABORTIONS INTO THE SECOND AND THIRD TRIMESTER The amendment allows abortions at any time to protect not only the physical, but also the mental health of the woman. This means that a health care provider could justify a late-term abortion due to a woman’s “emotional, psychological, [and] familial” concerns. An abortion provider would decide when a baby could survive outside the womb, leaving no clear protections for preborn children.</p>
<p>4. Notwithstanding subsection 3 of this Section, the general assembly may enact laws that regulate the provision of abortion after Fetal Viability provided that under no circumstance shall the Government deny, interfere with, delay, or otherwise restrict an abortion that in the good faith of a treating health care professional is needed to protect the life or physical or mental health of the pregnant person. ...</p>	<p>IS MISLEADING Referring to “miscarriage care” promotes a myth that a “right to abortion” is necessary to preserve care for miscarriages and ectopic pregnancies. This is false. Catholic hospitals have always provided comprehensive miscarriage care and will continue to do so regardless of the outcome of this petition.</p>
<p>8. For purposes of this Section, the following terms mean: (1) “Fetal Viability”, the point in pregnancy when, in the good faith judgment of a treating health care professional and based on the particular facts of the case, there is a significant likelihood of the fetus’s sustained survival outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures.</p>

Recently we learned that on November 5, Missourians will vote on a deeply troubling constitutional amendment that, if passed, would eliminate legal protections that currently safeguard the preborn as well as their mothers, fathers, families, and society from the harm of abortion. The Missouri Catholic Conference, the public policy arm of the state’s bishops, said in an Aug. 13 statement that the measure is an “extreme constitutional amendment that legalizes abortion at any stage of pregnancy with no protections for the preborn child, even when the child is capable of feeling pain.”

I strongly encourage you to inform yourself of this amendment. It is our duty to inform our consciences well and to use our vote responsibly. Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski said that the Church is speaking out on the issue “to look out for the common good of mothers and children. Destroying life — particularly innocent, vulnerable, human life

— is not what humanity was created for.” I will continue to share information with you as we work together to protect the dignity of all human life.

Join us in Church for the recitation of the Rosary following the 8 am Mass.


