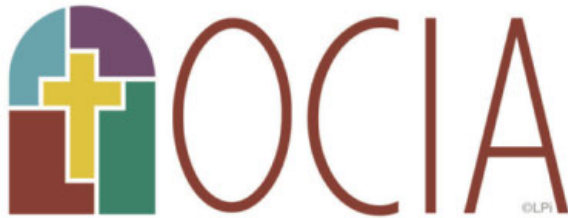

Bacitracin or Neosporin/triple antibiotic; Antifungal creams – clotrimazole, terbinafine; Cough and Cold Medications (eg Nyquil, Mucinex, Robitussin (brand or generic)); disinfectant wipes for surfaces; TUMS/antacid tablets

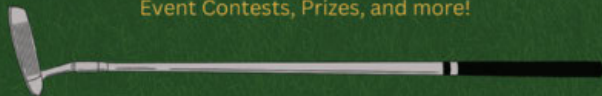

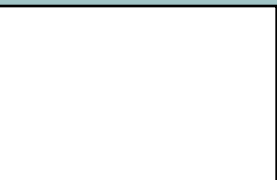
