I am edified by the outreach of our parish, especially by the work of Sr. Christine's Food Pantry and the St. Vincent de Paul Society. We now have another opportunity to serve our brothers and sisters in need. Many of you know, as part of the St. Louis Archdiocese reorganization *All Things New*, the archdiocese was divided up into three regions called Vicariates. Each Vicariate was assigned a priest called the Episcopal Vicar. St. Joseph Parish is part of the Southern Vicariate and Father Michael Lydon is our local Vicar.



Father Lydon is passionate about serving the poor and underserved, especially the homeless, who are now referred to as the "unhoused." Father Lydon has invited St. Joseph Parish to be part of the new ecumenical ministry called *The James II Project* that serves the unhoused and underserved of

our area. Currently, The James II Project is serving a hot meal, providing hot showers, and providing an opportunity for the unhoused and underserved to do a load of laundry every Tuesday at the Salvation Army located at 3740 Telegraph, Arnold, MO 63010. Father Lydon's goal is to offer an additional day each week, Thursday, by one of four Catholic Parishes in the Southern Vicariate, with St. Joseph being one of these parishes.

Our Parish is slated to cover the 1st Thursday of each month. We are looking for parishioners who are willing to seek the Face of Christ in our unhoused and underserved brothers and sisters. Workers will need to arrive between 9:00-10:00 am and will finish around 1:00 pm. 
