



The Corpus Christi Center hosts hundreds of events throughout the year, some that are family-related and others that are busi-



PERMIT ABORTION EVEN WHEN THE PREBORN CHILD CAN FEEL PAIN

Allows abortion for any reason before "viability," defined in the Amendment as a fetus being able to sustain life outside the womb without extraordinary medical measures.
