This group meets on the 1st Thursday of every month from 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm in the youth room. The night includes food, a small talk based on Scripture, games, and community bonding. We are so excited to be able to extend our faith formation opportunities to these children. And another event coming up next weekend is the annual Luke 18 retreat. This is a retreat that is part of the Confirmation preparation program. I am so thankful for our teens who help run this retreat for the younger students. Thanks to all our parishioners for their support of youth ministry!

**Seminarian Sam Ousley**

Our parish is blessed to collaborate with Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in the formation of men for the priesthood. And this year we will be blessed by the presence of Seminarian Sam Ousley from the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph as part of his pastoral formation. There are four dimensions upon which the formation of a man for the priesthood rest: Spiritual, Human, Intellectual and Pastoral formation. A man enters the seminary to be formed into a shepherd after the mind and heart of Jesus Christ, the Good Shepherd.

The goal of pastoral formation is to prepare men who will enter the Christian community with the charity of Christ the Good Shepherd; to stand and act in the community in the name and person of Jesus Christ, Head and Shepherd of the Church.

Sam will be with us Sunday mornings at Mass and will also be assisting with our youth ministry program. Please help me welcome Sam as he begins his service to our parish.
