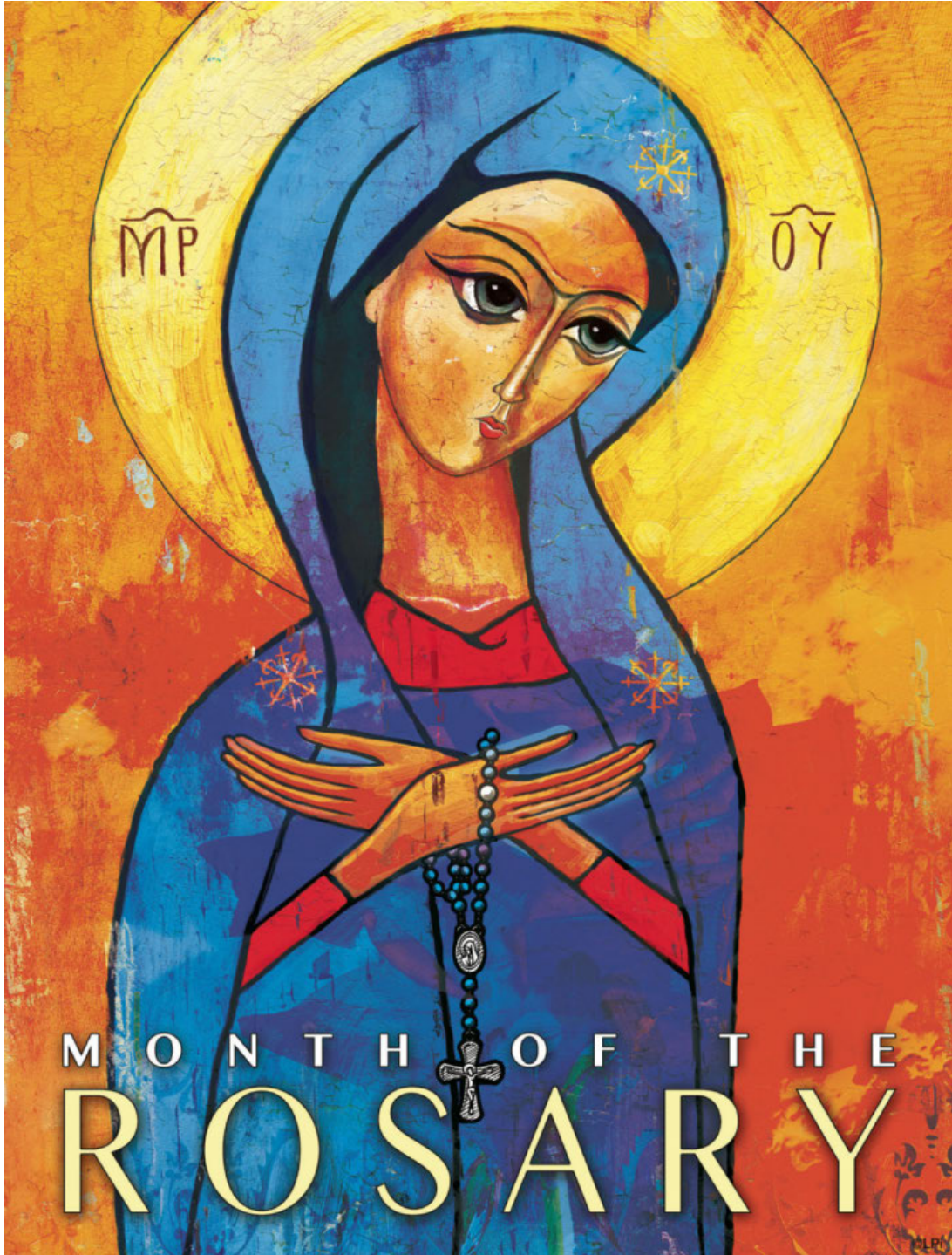

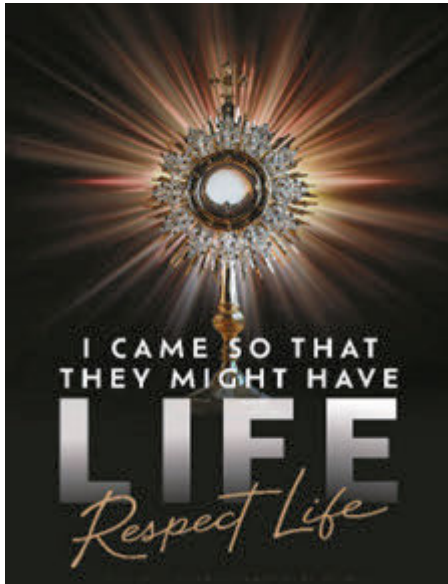

From the Desk of Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor

2024 RESPECT LIFE MONTH



In October, the Catholic Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month, and the first Sunday of October is designated as Respect Life Sunday.

Part of the impetus for the Eucharistic Revival was a concern that some Catholics do not believe, or at least do not understand, that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist. Even though our human senses perceive bread and wine, the Eucharist is Jesus—Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Similarly, many people do not realize or acknowledge the sanctity of human life when it is hidden in the womb. Both instances call for us to help others recognize these sacred gifts that may not be perceivable through our human senses. We need to help others understand that just because something may not be apparent to our eyes does not mean that it is not there or that it is not important.

We live in a society that rejects those who are weak, fragile, or vulnerable. Yet, it is precisely within these conditions that a person is most in need of our care and protection. Pope Francis reminds us that “every child who, rather than being born, is condemned unjustly to being aborted, bears the face of Jesus Christ, bears the face of the Lord, who even before he was born, and then just after birth, experienced the

world’s rejection.”

The U.S. bishops have affirmed that, while it is important to address all the ways in which human life is threatened, “abortion remains our pre-eminent priority as it directly attacks our most vulnerable brothers and sisters, destroying more than a million lives each year in our country alone.”

Jesus gave his very flesh to give us the gift of eternal life and invites us to the most profound experience of this gift in our celebration of the Eucharist. When we meet Jesus in the Eucharist, this encounter has the power to change us. The Eucharist has the power to transform the depths of our hearts and the heart of our culture. United to the power of his Eucharistic Presence, may we work to ensure that each person has life—and has it in abundance.

Helping A Neighbor in Need

In September 2024, a Neighbor in Need reached out to St Vincent de Paul asking for help with rent. She explained that while she works full time, she doesn't earn enough to keep up with all her expenses including rent, transportation costs, utilities, and food. She doesn't qualify for any government assistance, even though she is raising a six year old son by herself. She receives no child support from her ex-husband as his exact whereabouts are unknown. She described struggling to pay her rent on time each month, and the apartment complex adds a late fee every time and threatens her with eviction. She is on her own, with little family to turn to for financial assistance, child-care, or alternative housing. St Vincent de Paul was able to provide a partial payment for her September rent, and we also referred her to Sister Christine's Food Pantry for help with groceries. Thanks to our generous parishioners, we were able to provide a helping hand to this little family to achieve some financial security

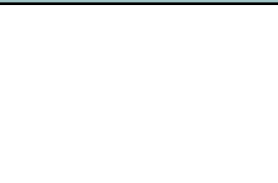
