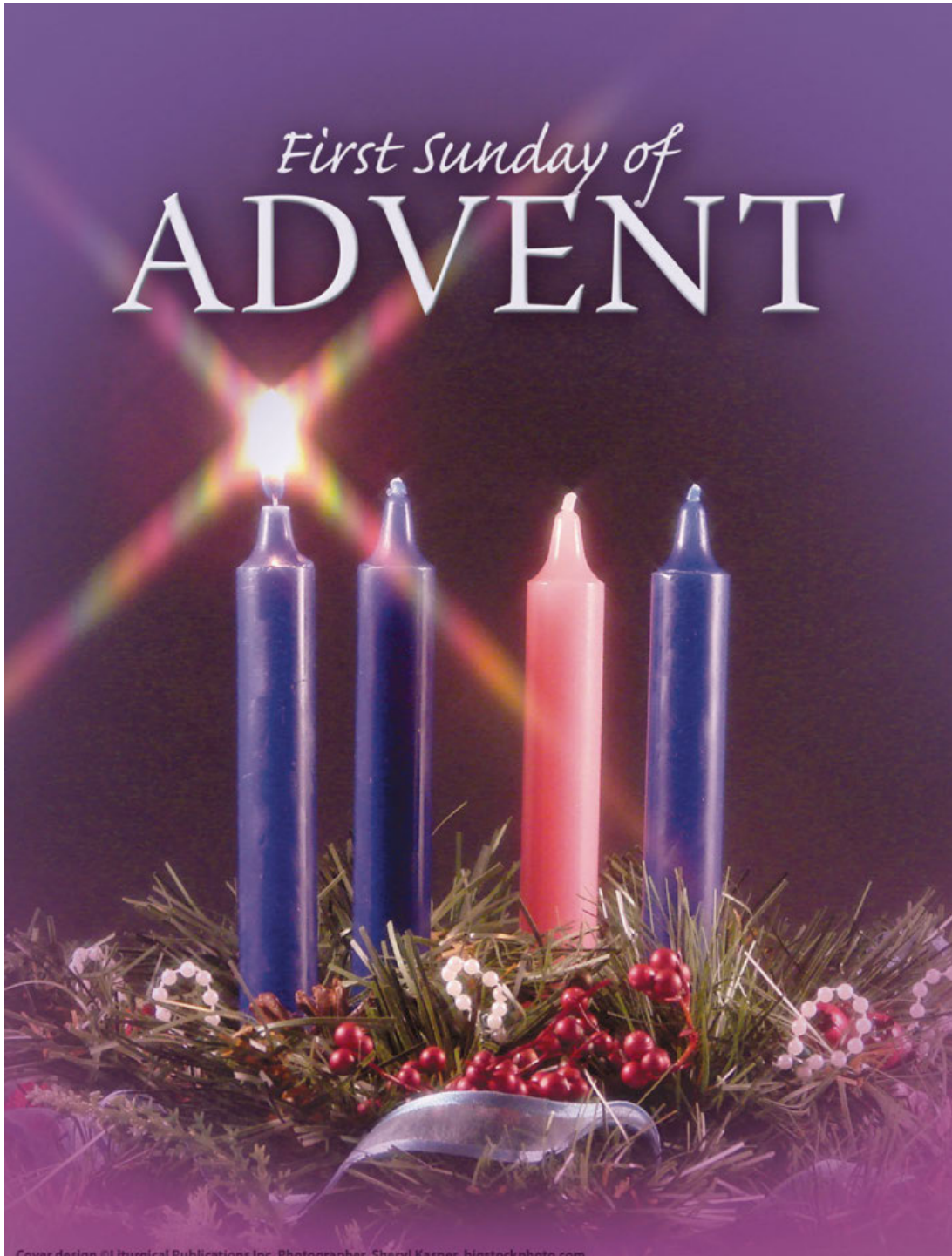

From the Desk of Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor

First Sunday of Advent

We have arrived at the powerful season of Advent, a season to prepare with awe and wonder for the Feast of the Incarnation of Jesus — born to us as Savior and Brother. It is a season to prepare for His return at the end of time. It is also a moment to remind ourselves that our individual judgment day is coming, too, when we will be called to give an account for all that God has given to us during our lifetimes. In other words, Advent is a steward’s season!

Our readings for the first week of Advent waste no time in calling our urgent attention to these themes of reflection and preparation. They seem to shout, “Wake up! Get ready!” and offer us some practical advice as we enter into this season.

The Gospel, from Luke, warns, “Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy from carousing and drunkenness and the anxieties of daily life.” How easy it is to lose focus on our Lord either by too much indulgence in our lives or by too much worry about our lives.

During Advent, we Christian stewards must ask ourselves some hard questions. Am I staying faithful to my prayer life? Am I using my energy and skills to serve others? Am I overly concerned about material gain? Am I relying on my “stuff” or my investments as my source of comfort or security? Am I living for the moment or for the coming of the Lord?

Get ready Christian stewards! He’s coming! Let us prepare with awe and wonder.

Blessing of an Advent Wreath 1st Sunday of Advent



The Advent Wreath is a wonderful tradition to help us visibly mark the passing of time before Christmas in the Church as well as in the home. The blessing of an Advent Wreath takes place on the **First Sunday of Advent** or on the evening before the First Sunday of Advent. When the blessing of the Advent Wreath is celebrated in the home, it is appropriate that it is blessed by a parent or another member of the family.

All make the sign of the cross

Leader: Our help is in the name of the Lord.

All: Who made heaven and earth.

Scripture Reading (Select one):

Isaiah 9 lines 1-2 & 5-6

Isaiah 63 lines 16-17 & 19, or

Isaiah 64 lines 2-7

Reader: The Word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

Prayer & Blessing

Leader (all join hands):

Lord our God,

we praise you for your Son, Jesus Christ: he is Emmanuel, the hope of the peoples, he is the wisdom that teaches and guides us, he is the Savior of every nation.

Lord God,

let your blessing come upon us as we light the candles of this wreath. May the wreath and its light be a sign of Christ’s promise to bring us salvation.

May he come quickly and not delay. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

All: Amen.

The blessing may conclude with a verse from “O Come, O Come, Emmanuel”:

O come, desire of nations, bind in one the hearts of humankind; bid ev’ry sad division cease and be thyself our Prince of peace.

Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel shall come to thee, O Israel.

The word “Advent” comes from the Latin word “adventus,” which means “a coming, approach, arrival.” When we expect guests to arrive at our homes, we turn the lights on; we anticipate their arrival and welcome them with joy. Advent wreaths and candles are commonly seen in Catholic churches during the liturgical season. The circular shape of the Advent wreath symbolizes God’s infinite love for us – it is never-ending, just like the true Light of the World, Jesus, who leads us into eternal life with Him. The materials of the Advent wreath similarly lead us to reflect on the everlasting nature of God. Many people also display Advent wreaths in their homes and light a candle each Sunday as families. Consider using the prayer service to bless your Advent wreath at home.

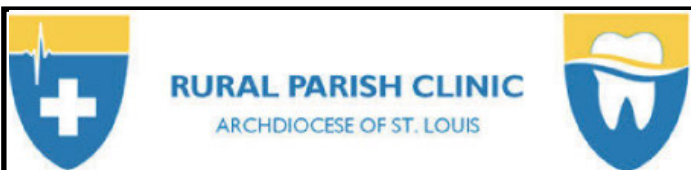

Allergy Medications (eg Claritin (loratadine), Zyrtec (cetirizine), Miralax (brand or generic), Stool softeners (docusate/colace), Tylenol/acetaminophen/non-aspirin pain reliever 500mg, Ibuprofen 200mg , Aleve/naproxen 220mg, Pain or heat patches or creams, Allergy nose spray (eg Flonase, Nasalide or Nasacort (brand or generic), 1% Hydrocortisone Cream, Antibiotic cream/ ointment. Bacitracin or triple antibiotic, Antifungal creams – clotrimazole, terbinafine, tolnaftate, Cough and Cold Medications (eg Nyquil, Mucinex, Robitussin (brand or generic), Disinfectant wipes for surfaces, TUMS/antacid tablets, Band-aids, Pill boxes for a week - Those for once daily and those with AM and PM for twice daily medications

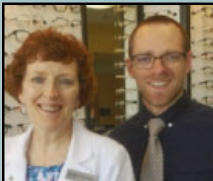
