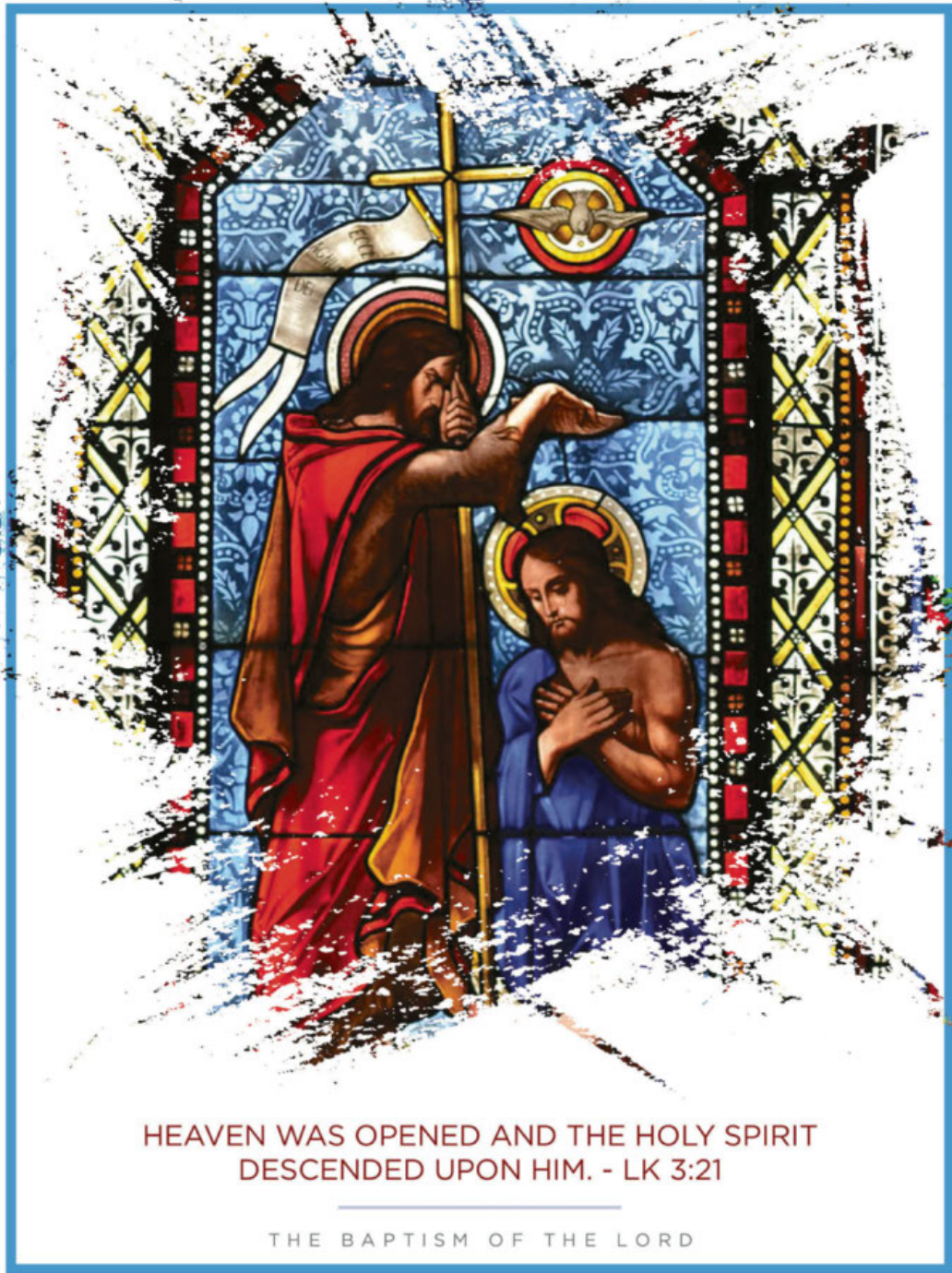

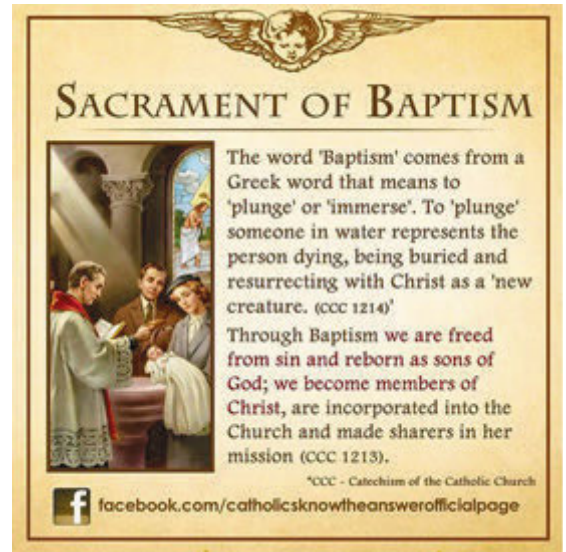




From the Desk of Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor

The Baptism of the Lord

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord. This feast ends the season of Christmas. Ordinary Time lasts from the day after this Feast to the Tuesday before Lent. The Church recalls Our Lord's second manifestation or epiphany which occurred at His baptism in the Jordan. 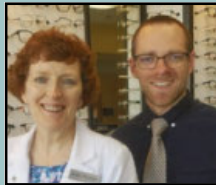
