

From the Desk of Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor

Lent

Be sure to make plans to start your Lenten pilgrimage this Wednesday by celebrating Mass. As the ashes are applied to your forehead in the sign of the cross and you hear the words, “Remember, you are dust and to dust you shall return,” recall the goal of our earthly journey towards heaven. This act symbolizes our mortality as well as our need for ongoing repentance. It is a reminder that this life is short and merely a foreshadowing of what we shall become through the redemption of Jesus Christ on the Cross. The work of our redemption will not be complete until we are raised from the dead, in resurrected bodies like His own and called to the eternal communion of heaven.

Remember that Ash Wednesday is a day of abstinence from meat for all Catholics over the age of 14. This is also a day of fasting for those ages of 18-59. Of course, if you’re older and can, you should fast. Abstinence means refraining from meat. Fast means one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted). No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence from meat. Here again Catholics will not hold themselves lightly excused, but if there is a serious health problem, this obligation would not apply.
