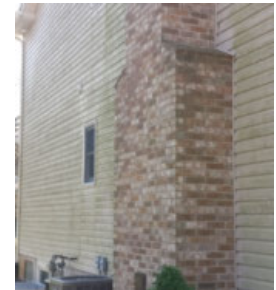
## *From the Desk of Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor*

### **Stewardship Opportunity**

As we continue to care for our parish community, I want to share a few important maintenance needs at the rectory. Just as our church is a house of prayer, the rectory serves as a home for your priests—a place of rest, work, and hospitality. Over time, like any home, it requires upkeep.

Currently, we need assistance with several projects, including:

- Storm clean-up – after the severe weather recently there are many branches down in the yard.

- Lawn restoration – the yard is in bad shape and could use some attention.

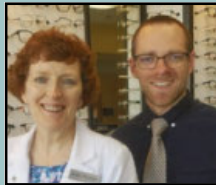
