**Parish Lenten Mission and Confession Night**

I hope you will take a little extra time this week to attend our Lenten Mission on April 8 and April 9 at 7pm in the church. There will be talks, reflection time, and hospitality. The speaker is Adam Wright, a Roman Catholic striving to live the universal call to holiness through his vocation as a husband and father of five. In his professional life, Adam serves as the on-air host for Covenant Network Catholic Radio, where he steers the morning drive show, "Roadmap to Heaven." With a personal aspiration to become a saint, Adam candidly acknowledges the challenges and mistakes along the way, hoping to inspire others on their own journey towards holiness. In 2024, Adam was diagnosed with stage four Neuroendocrine Cancer. Through God's grace, Adam has viewed his cancer journey as a journey with our Lord on the Way of the Cross. He will be speaking on the theme, hope in the midst of suffering. While there is no cost for the event, a free will offering will be taken to support Adam's ministry. Then also note on April 10 from 5:30-7:00pm, we will have our Lenten Confession Night with additional confessors available. I look forward to seeing you there.

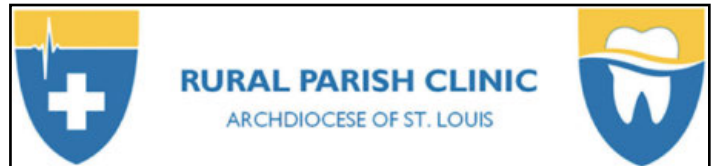

- disinfectant wipes for surfaces
- TUMS/antacid tablets
- Band-aids
- Multivitamins for adults or for women specifically

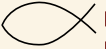

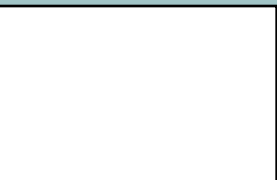

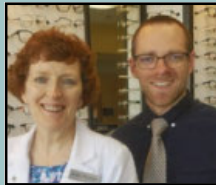
