

As St. John Paul II so beautifully pointed out, part of the genius of woman is the indispensable role she plays in showing all of humanity the tremendous value of every human person. Our mothers have this role in a preeminent way. They give us life. But a mother's role doesn't stop there. We know they are meant to feed us, to love us, to raise us, to pass on the faith and lead us to Jesus, to teach us by their actions and words that you are so important that God died to save us and make us his friend. How desperately our world needs mothers and their witness to human life. What a task! What an amazing person a mother is!

Fourth Sunday of Easter



Throughout the Easter season, our readings have given us glimpses into the life of the newborn Church and the bold witness of the early disciples in spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ to all who would listen. The disciples were the first to live a stewardship way of life, & their example is as relevant today as it was 2,000 years ago.

In the First Reading, from the Acts of the Apostles, we catch up with Paul & Barnabas in Antioch. While they certainly have some success in reaching many people there with the message of salvation, others are downright infuriated by their words & send them packing. Yet, we read that "the disciples were filled with joy & the Holy Spirit." Overall, it seems as if Paul & Barnabas had failed in Antioch. But seeing failure has not robbed them of their joy. What's more, they are filled to the brim with the abundant gifts of the Holy Spirit. How is this possible?

It is only possible because Paul & Barnabas saw themselves as nothing more & nothing less than stewards of Christ & His Good News. This realization brought them freedom – to offer themselves & their lives to others for the sake of the Gospel. The "results" of their efforts were up to God.

This Spirit-filled, joy-filled life is available to us all today. It can be achieved when we recognize, as did Paul & Barnabas, that all we have and all we are is a gift from God, meant to be shared with others for His glory. Of course, living as God's stewards does not guarantee a life of ease or a life free of sacrifice. Sometimes the steward's life involves challenges, requiring all the strength & love one has to give. 1. What is the purpose and mission of this ministry? Our Parish School of Religion seeks to assist parents as the primary educators of their children in the faith. Our dedicated catechists help the children learn the truths of our faith, practice living out the Catholic faith, & grow in their relationship with Jesus.

2. What are some of the programs offered by this ministry?

We offer 2 formats for families to select from when choosing to enroll in PSR. We have a traditional weekly class model on Wednesday evenings, & a month Sunday morning option for families who need greater flexibility. Our Wednesday group puts on a Living Nativity & Living Stations each year that are very special! Our Sunday group participates as a family exploring various faith topics with hands on activities, games, prayer & more!

3. What advice would you give to others who are considering joining? If you feel the nudge to help kids and their family come to know the Lord more fully, I'd love to chat! There are a variety of ways to be involved: catechist, aide, PSR sub, or more background work too. Never underestimate how much God will lavish upon you when you say 'yes!' to Him!
