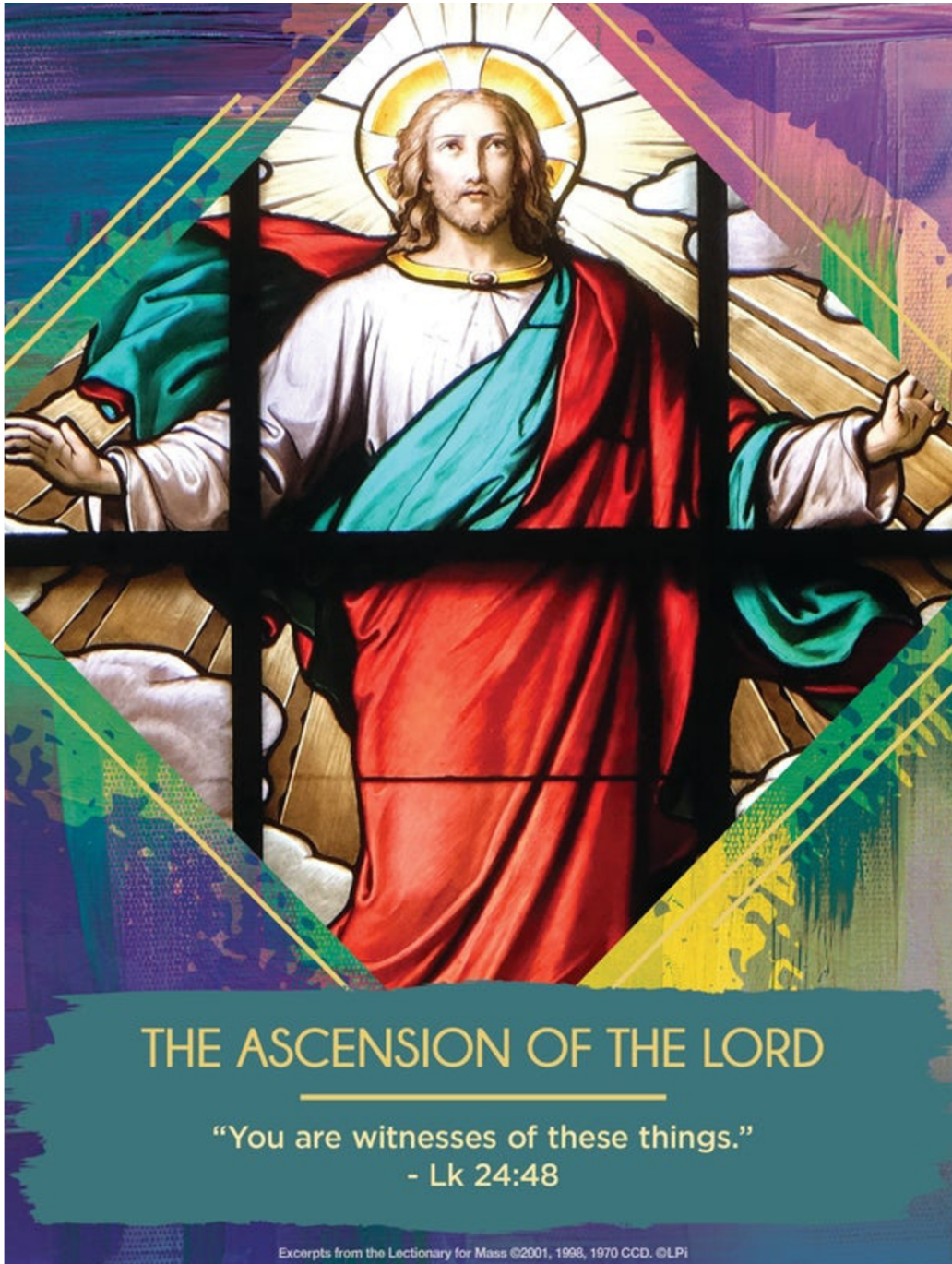

The Sacred Heart of Jesus

The St. Joseph School **Occupational and Speech Therapy Program** for students. Established 2025!

MEET OUR PROGRAM'S PATRON, ST. JOSEPH CUPERTINO



St. Joseph of Cupertino was born in 1603 in Cupertino, which is now the Italian province of Lecce. As a child, he was a poor student, slow to learn and easily distracted. Modern educators might diagnose him with a learning disability, but during his lifetime, he was simply dismissed as slow and lazy...

He later became a servant in a Franciscan monastery. It was there that his life began to change. Joseph's work consisted of menial tasks such as caring for the horses, and he adopted a life of simplicity, humility, and sacrifice. Eventually, he was able to enter the Franciscan order and become a priest. After ordination, he continued to grow in holiness and he experienced miraculous visions and was even reported to levitate and "fly" sometimes when in prayer or while offering Mass.

As fascinating—or incredible—as levitation might be, I find it most helpful to reflect on the ways that St. Joseph of Cupertino struggled as a student, and his tendency toward angry outbursts. Yet he overcame these flaws in the end. That's where most of us find ourselves, after all, in the struggles of everyday life. Even in the midst of earthly limitations, in this great saint we find inspiration in holiness and encouragement toward the challenge every one of us faces—overcoming obstacles and weaknesses in this world as we make our way toward the next. - Excerpt from SETON REFLECTIONS, Danielle Bean

CONQUER THERAPY



St. Joseph School will begin a partnership with **Conquer Therapy Services** for the 2025-2026 School Year.

They will support students & their families + collaborate with teachers.

"At Conquer Therapy Services, our research-based therapies aim to meet your child's unique needs by empowering you, your child, and the people who are with your child within all environments."

SPEECH THERAPY

Helps your child improve their ability to speak and communicate with language.

- Early language skills (especially children learning to talk and communicate).
- Ability to use your voice.
- Language comprehension (how well you understand words and language).
- Fluency (how well and how comfortably you can use language).
- Clarity and expression (how easily you can communicate what you want to).

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Provides treatment to help children meet developmental milestones, overcome sensory challenges and improve self-care, play and self-regulation skills.

- Moving (fine motor skills like using the small muscles of their hands).
- Learning (cognitive skills).
- Playing (social and emotional skills).
- Skills needed for their education (pre-writing, writing and scissor skills).

EXPLORING THERAPY OR TRANSITIONING THERAPY TO CONQUER

If you are interested in scheduling an OT and/or Speech screening for your child, please reach out to Amanda Dailey. She will be the liaison between St. Joseph and Conquer Therapy Services.

Amanda and her husband Sean have 4 children (3 in the school), and they will be helping to launch the program. Their son is currently in weekly OT and Speech at Conquer Therapy Services. These therapies along with the work of Dr. William Walsh, PhD's nutrient therapy intervention has been a game changer for their family.

Amanda will be compiling a list of students to share with Conquer in order to begin screenings, and if desired, further evaluation. This will enable Conquer to start preparing a schedule for in-school therapy for the 2025-2026 School Year.



FUNCTIONAL LIFESTYLE + NUTRIENT THERAPY

In addition to Occupational and Speech Therapy, we wanted to present families with resources to explore functional lifestyle interventions and nutrient therapy to support their children's overall wellbeing.
