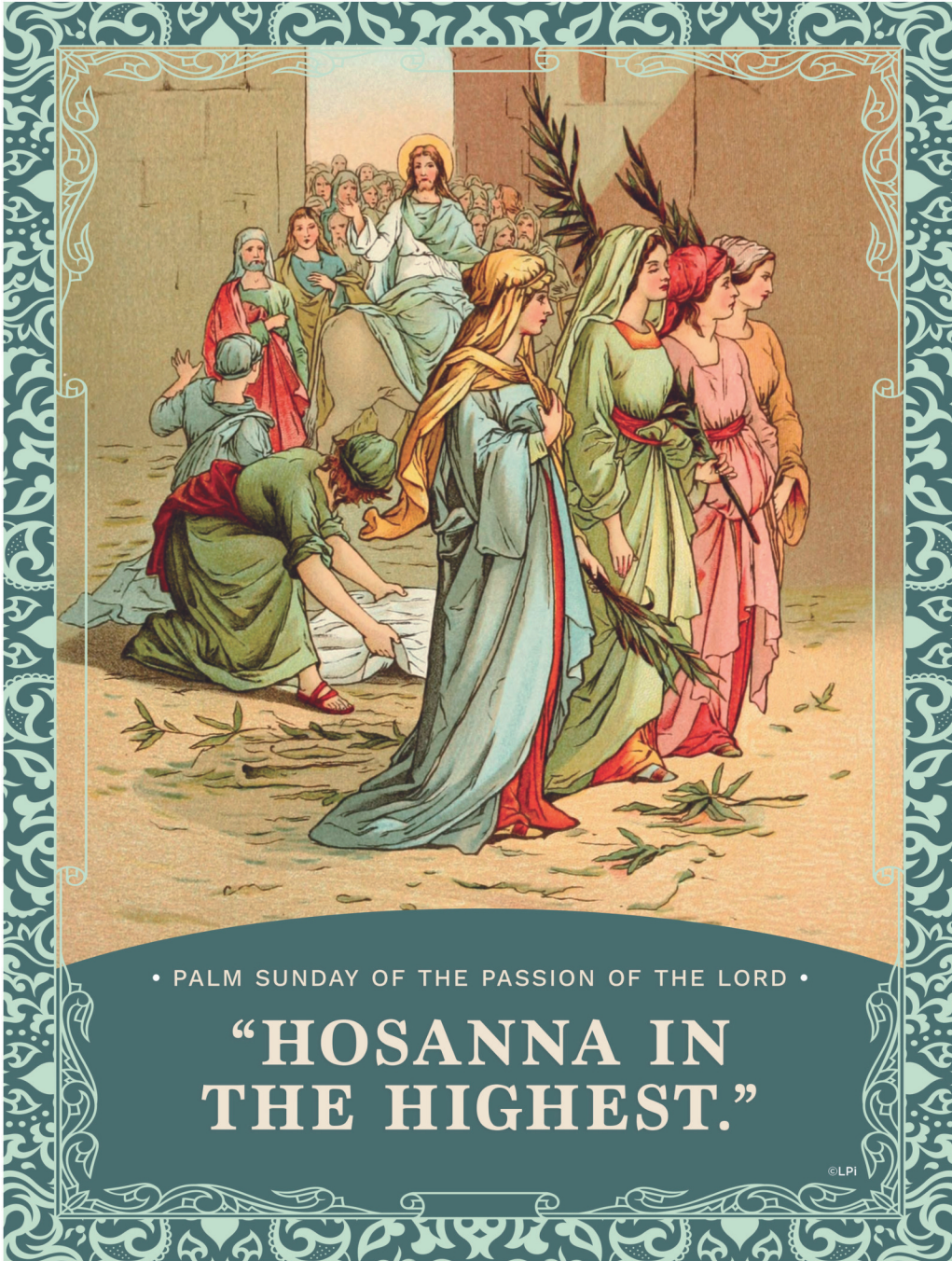

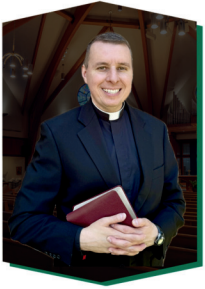

Holy Week

As we wave our palms this Palm Sunday, we relive Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, the gateway to Holy Week—the most sacred days of the liturgical year. This is our time to walk with Christ from acclaim to the Cross, and into the glory of Resurrection.

The heart of Holy Week is the **Paschal Triduum**:

- **Holy Thursday:** Join us for the Mass of the Lord's Supper, commemorating the institution of the Eucharist and priesthood. Experience the foot-washing and procession of the Blessed Sacrament.
- **Good Friday:** Venerate the Cross in the Celebration of the Lord's Passion—a profound liturgy of suffering and redemption.
- **Easter Vigil:** The "mother of all vigils," with the lighting of the Paschal Candle, baptisms, and first Eucharist of Easter—don't miss this renewal of our faith!

These celebrations are not spectators' events; they invite your full, active participation as the Body of Christ. Come, pray, adore—let the Triduum transform your heart. Finally, mark your calendars for Easter Sunday Masses (schedules in this bulletin and on our website). Arrive early, as crowds gather to proclaim, "Christ is risen!" May this Holy Week draw us deeper into the Paschal Mystery. See you at church!

Lenten Confession and Parish Holy Hour

During these final days of Lent, be sure to take time to celebrate the Sacrament of Confession. On Monday, March 30, we will have extra confessors to hear confessions from 5:30-7:00pm. And on Wednesday, April 1, we will have our parish holy hour and confessions with guest priest, Fr. Charles Samson, to lead us in prayer. A social will follow. All are invited.

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Hosanna to the Messiah!

While Jesus would not be crowned an earthly king, Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem has many parallels to the Messianic expectations of the Hebrew people. Before entering, Jesus requisitions a donkey from its owner. In the ancient world, kings had this right. Yet the animal that Jesus requests is rare -- a colt upon which no one else has sat yet. Yet, it's a donkey. This is no great war-charger, no magnificent animal. Jesus acts with all the authority of an earthly king, yet his kingdom is one of simplicity and peace. As the disciples throw cloaks over the donkey, the crowd spreads theirs on the road. This ancient gesture dates back to the line of kings descended from David. Not only are these physical kingly gestures, but the crowd of followers cries out in jubilation and praise. The Messiah has come to Jerusalem!

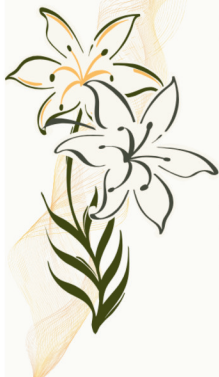

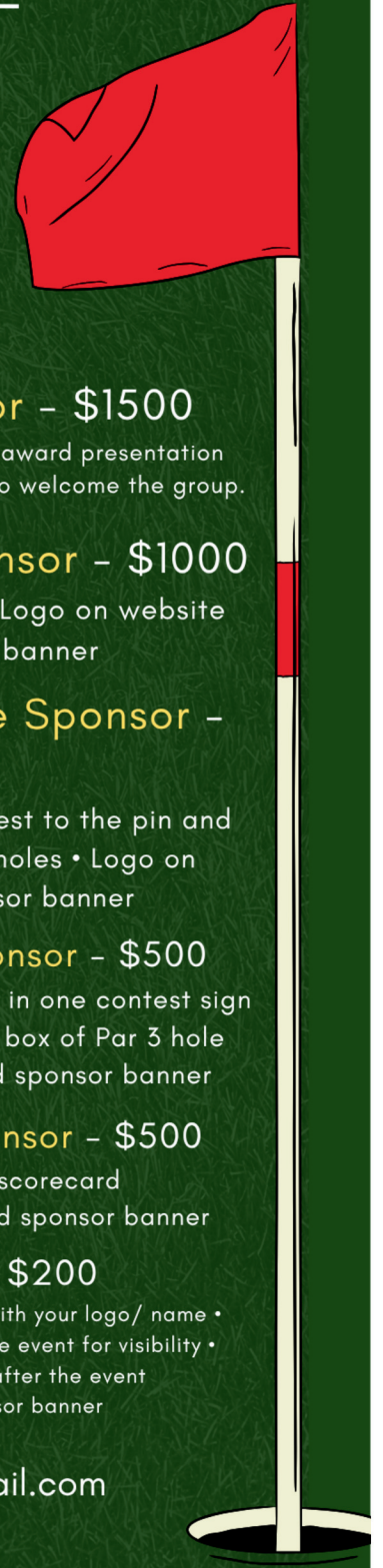
