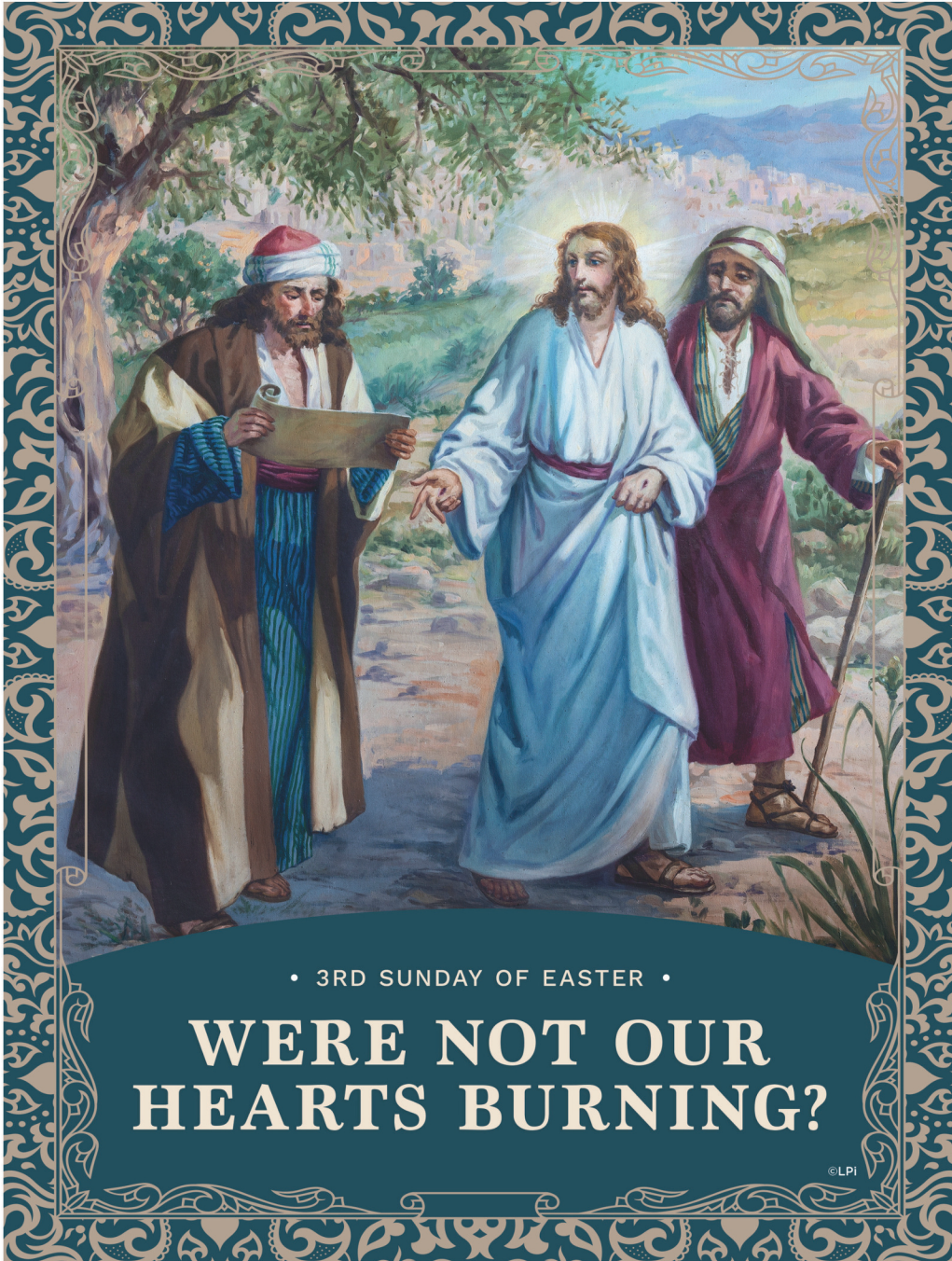

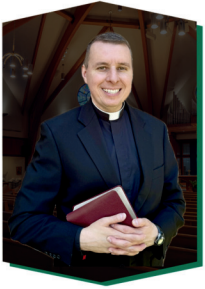

From the Desk of
Fr. Anthony Yates, Pastor



Every day in our parish, I am blessed to witness acts of kindness that reflect the love of Christ. They remind me of the patron of our city and archdiocese, Saint Louis, who welcomed the poor to his own table and shared his meals with them 800 years ago. In that same spirit of compassionate generosity, I invite you to join me and your fellow parishioners with Grateful Hearts Serving Others in supporting the Annual Catholic Appeal of the Archdiocese of St. Louis.

Gifts to the Appeal bring the love and mercy of Christ to life: teaching and sharing our faith, educating children, caring for retired clergy, forming young men for priestly vocations, and performing countless corporal works of mercy. Our own parish is helped, as well, through grants we received to help us with our mission:

- Ensuring Parish Viability Grant for debt reduction in the amount of \$45,000.
- Parish Emergency Grant for maintenance repairs in cafeteria in the amount of \$5,443.
- Food Pantry Grant for Sister Christine's Food Pantry in the amount of \$3,800.

In addition, many parishioners benefit from services the archdiocese provides which are funded by the Appeal such as:

- The Missionaries of Joy formation initiative sponsored by the Office of Evangelization and Discipleship.
- The Catholic Men/Women for Christ Conference sponsored by the Office of Evangelization and Discipleship.
- The archdiocesan marriage preparation classes sponsored by the Office of Marriage and Family Life for engaged couples.
- Kenrick-Glennon Seminary is supported by the ACA, and in 2025, the following seminarians served in our parish: Mr. Garrett Hugeback and Mr. Jacob Price.

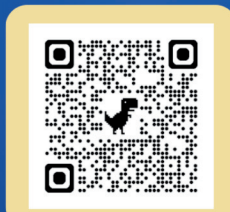
