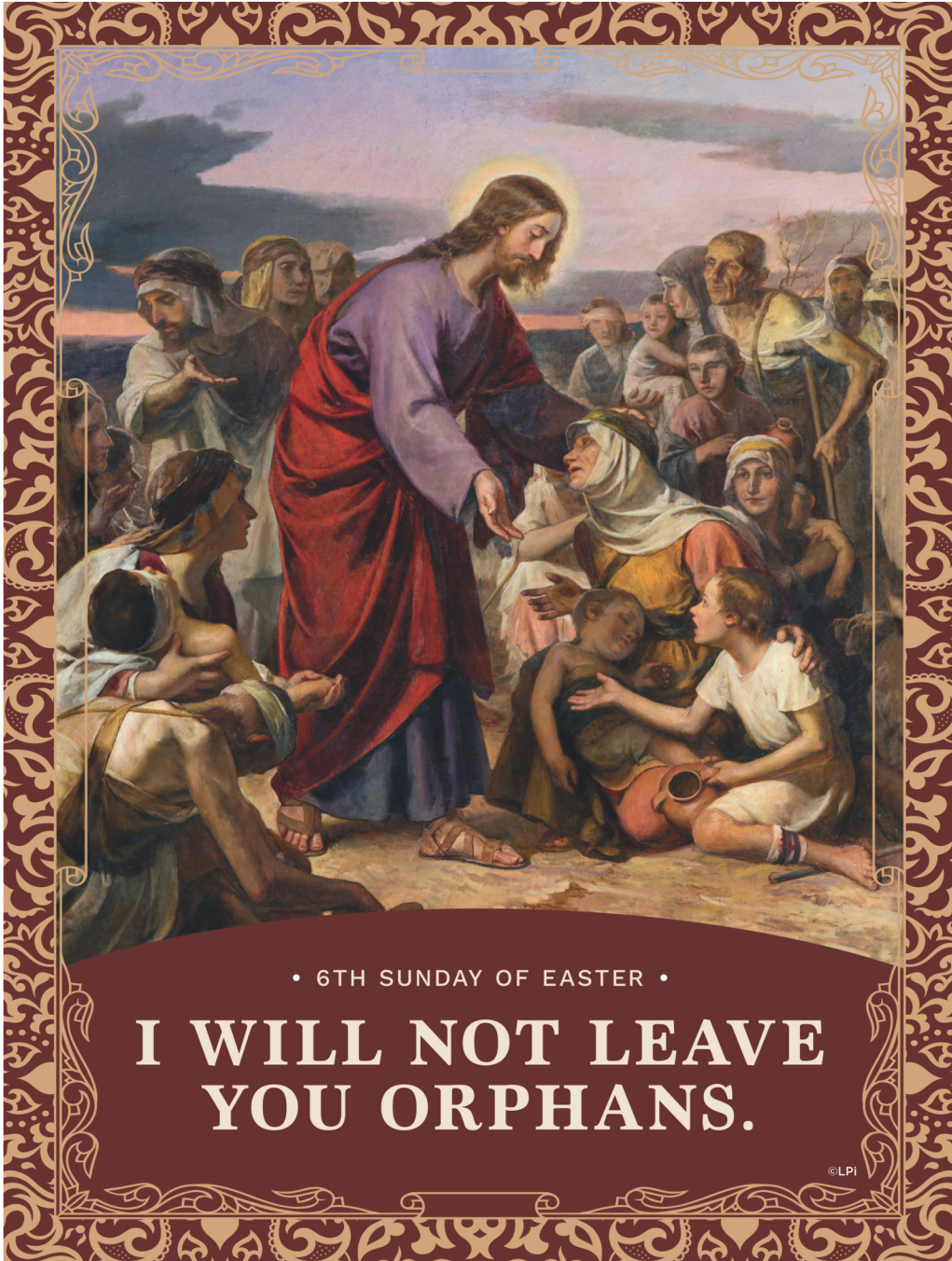

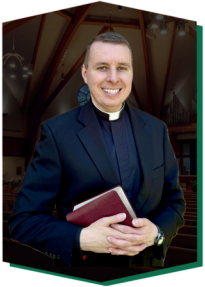

### A Mother's Love Reflects God's Love

As we celebrate Mother's Day, we pause to give thanks for the gift of mothers—those women who have given us life, nurtured us, sacrificed for us, and loved us in ways that often go unseen and unspoken. The Church has always recognized that motherhood is not simply a role, but a vocation—a sacred calling that reflects something profound about God Himself.

St. John Paul II once wrote, "The mother is she who can take the place of all others, but whose place no one else can take." In those words, we hear the uniqueness and irreplaceable beauty of a mother's love. Motherhood, at its heart, is a participation in God's own creative and nurturing love. **Candidate 1: Gloria Esparza**

After a few years at home with my children, during which I continued substitute teaching, I returned to the education setting as a middle school registrar. I also currently serve as the Alumni Relations Coordinator for St. Pius X, where I work to strengthen connections within the school community. As an active member of the St. Joseph School community, I have been involved in the Home and School Association, serving as a room parent for all three years my children have attended and leading Teacher Appreciation Week for the past two years. As a current St. Joseph parent with children in PreK3 and Kindergarten, I am deeply invested in the school's success and future. I am passionate about supporting students, families, and teachers, and I would be honored to serve as a thoughtful, experienced voice on the St. Joseph School Board.

**Candidate 5 - Crystal Pierce**
